14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 13A-103, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 13A-103. A. The election of members of the board of
18	education of every school district and technology center school
19	district shall be conducted on the second Tuesday in February of
20	each year, except in any year when a Presidential Preferential
21	Primary is held in February, then the election shall be held on the
22	same day as the Presidential Preferential Primary.
23	If no candidate receives more than fifty percent (50%) of the
24	votes cast in the election provided for in this subsection, an

election between the two candidates with the highest number of votes shall be conducted on the first Tuesday in April of that year.

- B. Elections on the question of making a levy or levies for schools under Section 9, Section 9B or Section 10 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution shall be held on the second Tuesday in February of each year, except in any year when a Presidential Preferential Primary is held in February, then the election shall be held on the same day as the Presidential Preferential Primary first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of any even-numbered year or on the same date as any normally scheduled school board election if the question failed at a previous November election.
- C. The board of education of every school district or technology center school district may call a special election for the purpose of voting on any matter or question authorized by law.

 A call for a special election shall be approved by three-fourths

 (3/4) of the membership of the board of education.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2018.
