6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to autonomous vehicles; defining
8 term; establishing certain regulations for the
9 operation of autonomous vehicles; providing for
10 codification; providing an effective date; and
11 declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 12-103 of Title 47, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. As used in this section, "autonomous vehicle" means a motor
17 vehicle that uses artificial intelligence, sensors and global
18 positioning system coordinates to drive itself without the active
19 intervention of a human operator.

20 B. The Department of Public Safety shall adopt regulations
21 authorizing the operation of autonomous vehicles on all highways
22 within the state. This includes, but is not limited to:

23 1. Establishing minimum safety standards for autonomous
24 vehicles and their operation;

- 1 2. Setting forth requirements that an autonomous vehicle must
2 meet before it may be operated on a highway within the state;
3 3. Providing for the testing of autonomous vehicles; and
4 4. Setting forth requirements for the insurance that is
5 required to test or operate an autonomous vehicle on a highway
6 within the state.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
