15	Any applicant approved to mitigate extraordinary costs
16	associated with the February 2021 extreme weather event through a
17	loan mechanism prescribed in Section 9050 et seq. or 9070 et seq. of
18	Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall take strategic action to
19	proactively prepare for future weather events that may occur to
20	protect consumers and prevent outages or extraordinary costs
21	associated with a future extreme weather event. Strategic action
22	under this act may include, but not be limited to:
23	1. Burying lines underground;
24	2. Shielding transformers; and
