7	An Act relating to environment and natural resources; amending 27A O.S. 2011, Section 2-7-120, which
8	relates to liquid waste disposal; correcting certain reference; modifying fee for certain waste disposal
9	into underground injection wells; and declaring an emergency.

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 27A O.S. 2011, Section 2-7-120, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 2-7-120. Any person subject to regulation by the
16	Department of Environmental Quality disposing of liquid waste other
17	than hazardous waste in an underground injection well <u>that is</u>
18	required to be permitted shall pay a fee of two-hundredths of one
19	cent (0.002) <u>(0.02)</u> per gallon for such disposal, provided that the
20	total fee shall be not less than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00)
21	nor more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per year. The
22	total fee for injection of drinking water treatment residuals into a
23	Class V underground injection well shall be not less than Two
24	Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars

(\$5,000.00) per year. Said The fee shall be paid to the Department on a quarterly basis within one (1) month following the close of each quarter for the waste disposed in that preceding quarter. Said The fees shall be deposited into the Department of Environmental Quality Revolving Fund. SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 55-1-496 MJM 1/14/2015 1:47:58 PM
