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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 5060.20a, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 5060.20a. A. The Oklahoma Center for the Advancement
18	of Science and Technology (OCAST), in conjunction with the
19	Commercialization Center, may develop and implement a technology
20	business financing program to provide funding and financing for and
21	to assist qualified Oklahoma enterprises to commercialize new
22	products, services, technology, innovations, and processes. In
23	order to obtain funding or financing from the technology business
24	financing program, a recipient shall be required to obtain separate

1 private investment or funding, and may also be required to pay 2 royalties, fees, interest, profits, or other payments generated or arising from the sale, lease, licensing, distribution, manufacture, 3 marketing, or development of products, services, technology, 4 5 innovations, and processes, whether alone or in conjunction with 6 others, or generated or arising from a sale, acquisition, merger, or other transfer or takeover of the enterprise. Any such royalties, 7 fees, interest, profits, or other payments or return of funding and 8 9 financing shall be retained for use in the program. OCAST, in 10 conjunction with the Commercialization Center, shall establish 11 program specifications. OCAST may contract with the 12 Commercialization Center or other qualified entity to operate and manage the program. Program funds shall not be used to pay 13 administrative, management, or operating expenses of OCAST. 14 B. Enterprises that receive funding pursuant to subsection A of 15 this section shall make a binding commitment to provide data 16 annually through a survey provided by OCAST, in conjunction with the 17 Commercialization Center and the Oklahoma Tax Commission. The 18 binding commitment to provide data shall be for five (5) years or 19 until the repayment amount has been paid, whichever is later. The 20 data required by the survey shall include but not be limited to jobs 21
