        Section 245. A. It shall be the duty of the county clerk to

1 B. If the clerk provides possesses or maintains records in an 2 electronic format, the clerk shall make such records available to 3 the public and may charge a reasonable fee for providing such records. For purposes of this section, "reasonable fee" shall mean 4 5 the fee being charged by the clerk as of January 1, 2013, but shall not exceed twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per page or fifteen cents 6 (\$0.15) per page for providing more than three thousand five hundred 7 pages in an electronic format. All recording devices for providing 9 records in an electronic format shall be supplied by the county clerk. News media obtaining records in an electronic format for a 10 news purpose and licensed abstractors performing their duties 11 pursuant to state law shall be exempt from the fees provided for in 12 this subsection. Nothing in this section shall be construed to 13 allow county clerks to provide all or part of a tract index for use 14 in any commercial purpose, nor shall this section be construed to 15 16 prohibit access to, and the use or dissemination of digital images 17 of other records for commercial purposes. 18

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
