14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1750.4, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 1750.4. A. On and after January 1, 1988, no person may
18	be employed or operate as a <u>an armed</u> security guard, private
19	investigator, security agency, or investigative agency until a
20	license therefor has been issued by the Council on Law Enforcement
21	Education and Training pursuant to the Oklahoma Security Guard and
22	Private Investigator Act.
23	B. On or after November 1, 2019, a person employed or operating
24	as an unarmed security guard shall have thirty (30) days from the

1	date of employment to secure a license issued by the Council on Law
2	Enforcement Education and Training pursuant to the Oklahoma Security
3	Guard and Private Investigator Act.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
