BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 140.7 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All departments, agencies, penal institutions, detention centers and county jails that are otherwise authorized to enter into a contract to purchase inmate calling and communication services shall, when entering into such purchase agreements, contract for the lowest possible cost to the telephone user. Any department, agency, penal institution, detention center or county jail entering into such a contract shall not accept or receive revenue in excess of its direct operating cost for establishing and administering the inmate
