13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 51 O.S. 2011, Section 253, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 253. A. Except as provided in subsection B of this
16	section, no governmental entity shall substantially burden a
17	person's free exercise of religion even if the burden results from a
18	rule of general applicability.
19	B. No governmental entity shall substantially burden a person's
20	free exercise of religion unless it demonstrates that application of
21	the burden to the person is:
22	1. Essential to further a compelling governmental interest; and
23	2. The least restrictive means of furthering that compelling
24	governmental interest.

1	C. A school or school district policy that prohibits a student
2	from wearing tribal regalia during a high school graduation
3	ceremony, if such conduct is motivated by the religious beliefs of
4	the student, shall be deemed to substantially burden the free
5	exercise of religion by the student. For purposes of this section,
6	a "compelling governmental interest" shall not include the school
7	policy described in this subsection if the interest is primarily for
8	aesthetic uniformity.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
