16	Municipalities, political subdivisions, and counties may enter
17	into agreements or memoranda of understanding with state agencies
18	which respond to search and seizure activities of marijuana to
19	compensate municipalities, political subdivisions, or counties for
20	the use of county or municipal equipment during search and seizure
21	events. Agreements or memoranda made pursuant to the provisions of
22	this section shall not be reimbursed at a higher rate than the
23	federal schedule rate for equipment usage.
24	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
