12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 13A-103, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 13A-103. A. 1. The general election of members of the
15	board of education of every school district and technology center
16	school district shall be conducted on the first <u>second</u> Tuesday of
17	April November of each odd-numbered year, and on the first Tuesday
18	after the first Monday of November in each even-numbered year.
19	2. The primary election of members of the board of education of
20	every school district and technology center school district, if
21	necessary, shall be conducted on the second Tuesday in February
22	September of each odd-numbered year, except in any year when a
23	Presidential Preferential Primary is held in February, then the
24	election shall be held on the same day as the Presidential

 even-numbered year.

3 3. If only two candidates qualify to have their names appear on 4 the ballot, the names of both candidates shall appear on the ballot 5 at the board of education general election.

If more than two candidates qualify to have their names 6 4. appear on the ballot, the names of all such candidates shall appear 7 on the ballot at the board of education primary election. 8 А 9 candidate receiving more than fifty percent (50%) of the votes cast 10 in the board of education primary election shall be elected to the office. If no candidate receives more than fifty percent (50%) of 11 12 the votes cast in the board of education primary election, then the two candidates with the highest number of votes shall appear on the 13 ballot at the board of education general election. 14

B. Elections on the question of making a levy or levies for
schools under Section 9, Section 9B or Section 10 of Article X of
the Oklahoma Constitution shall be held on the second Tuesday in
February of each year, except in any year when a Presidential
Preferential Primary is held in February, then the election shall be
held on the same day as the Presidential Preferential Primary.

C. The board of education of every school district or
technology center school district may call a special election for
the purpose of voting on any matter or question authorized by law.

1SECTION 2.AMENDATORY26 O.S. 2021, Section 13A-105, is2amended to read as follows:

Section 13A-105. Candidates for member of the board of 3 education of every school district or technology center school 4 5 district shall file declarations of candidacy in the same place and with the same officials as candidates for county office. 6 The declaration of candidacy to be signed by the candidate shall have an 7 attachment to be signed by the candidate listing the requirements of 8 a candidate for election or reelection to a school board as set 9 forth in Sections 13A-106 and 5-105a of this title and Sections 5-10 110, 5-110.1, and 5-113 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and 11 12 the candidate shall swear or affirm that he or she is eligible to run for the office or serve in the office if elected. Candidates 13 shall file no earlier than 8:00 a.m. on the first Monday second 14 Wednesday in December April through no later than 5:00 p.m. on the 15 following Wednesday next succeeding Friday. For school districts 16 and technology center school districts located in more than one 17 county, filing may be either in the county wherein supervision of 18 the district is located or in the county where the candidate 19 resides. 20

 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
