18	Section 754. Nothing in the Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act

23	behalf of others without knowledge that it is an unlawful practice;

Actions or transactions regulated under laws administered by 2 the Corporation Commission or any other regulatory body or officer 3 acting under statutory authority of this state or the United States, or to acts done by retailers or other persons acting in good faith 4 5 on the basis of information or matter supplied by others and without knowledge of the deceptive character of such information or matter; 6 7 provided, however, nothing in this section shall prohibit any other regulatory body or officer acting under statutory authority of this 8 9 state or the United States to enforce the laws and regulations under 10 such statutory authority; and 11 3. The collection of monies denominated as gross receipts tax 12 on mixed beverages, sales tax or use tax, or asserted injuries or 13 damages that are monies that have been collected as, or denominated as, gross receipts tax on mixed beverages, sales tax or use tax, and 14 which have been remitted to the Oklahoma Tax Commission or other 15 governmental taxing authority. 16 SECTION 2.
