9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as  
11 last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.  
12 2018, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
14 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
15 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as  
16 provided by this section.

17 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
18 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
19 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
20 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
21 registered for the current year.

22 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
23 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
24 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.

1 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
2 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
3 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
4 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and  
5 amateur radio operator license plates.

6 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
7 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
8 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
9 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
10 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
11 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
12 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
13 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
14 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
15 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
16 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
17 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

18 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
19 follows:

20 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be  
21 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United  
22 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war  
23 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification  
24 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war

1 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having  
2 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving  
3 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not  
4 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by  
5 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war  
6 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one  
7 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special  
8 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to  
9 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
10 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

11 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be  
12 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National  
13 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide  
14 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be  
15 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

16 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National  
18 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide  
19 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be  
20 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

21 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed  
22 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States  
23 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry  
24 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or

1 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member  
2 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably  
3 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying  
4 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military  
5 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or  
6 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or  
7 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof  
8 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required  
9 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

10 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such  
11 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been  
12 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply  
13 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each  
14 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.  
15 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

16 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are  
18 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse  
19 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is  
20 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the  
21 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon  
22 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action  
23 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse  
24 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each

1 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in  
2 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity  
3 of one (1) ton or less;

4 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be  
5 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper  
6 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs  
7 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such  
8 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.  
9 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate  
10 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
11 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been  
12 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not  
13 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated  
14 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one  
15 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The  
16 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee  
17 provided by this section for special license plates;

18 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be  
19 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the  
20 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
21 the United States as being:

22 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December  
23 7, 1941,  
24

- 1           b.    stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of  
2                   7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,  
3                   the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to  
4                   exceed three (3) miles, and  
5           c.    a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
6                   States Armed Forces.

7           Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate  
8 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
9 less;

10          9.    Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for  
11 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States  
12 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United  
13 States as being:

- 14           a.    a member of the United States Armed Forces in February  
15                   of 1945,  
16           b.    stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate  
17                   vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and  
18           c.    a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
19                   States Armed Forces.

20          Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each  
21 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

22          Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall  
23 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and  
24 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the

1 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."  
2 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such  
3 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other  
4 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the  
5 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of  
6 registration after the initial issue;

7 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be  
8 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the  
9 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
10 the United States as being:

- 11 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,  
12 1944,
- 13 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of  
14 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such  
15 participation cannot be verified by the United States  
16 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
17 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its  
18 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from  
19 the person applying for the license plate, and
- 20 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
21 States Armed Forces.

22 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for  
23 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

24

1           11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were  
3 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse  
4 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by  
5 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action  
6 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person  
7 was killed in action and that the person making the application is  
8 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse  
9 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two  
10 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)  
11 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special  
12 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to  
13 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
14 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

15           12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be  
16 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were  
17 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply  
18 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification  
19 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making  
20 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent  
21 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two  
22 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one  
23 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special  
24 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to



1 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
2 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

3 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be  
4 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the  
5 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the  
6 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or  
7 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a  
8 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
9 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United  
12 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such  
13 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each  
14 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

15 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be  
16 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal  
17 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police  
18 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and  
19 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council  
20 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may  
21 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated  
22 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of  
23 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common  
24 education police department by either an identification card or

1 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma  
2 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for  
3 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial  
4 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of  
5 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in  
6 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;  
7 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design  
8 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in  
9 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

10 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United  
12 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be  
13 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of  
14 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having  
15 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from  
16 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may  
17 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a  
18 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

19 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall  
20 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia  
21 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold  
22 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,  
23 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which  
24 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate

1 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at  
2 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.  
3 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words  
4 "WORLD WAR II";

5 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
6 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United  
7 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be  
8 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of  
9 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having  
10 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June  
11 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former  
12 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for  
13 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

14 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall  
15 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia  
16 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold  
17 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or  
18 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member  
19 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the  
20 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two  
21 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the  
22 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

23 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be  
24 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and

1 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or  
2 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only  
3 be produced upon application;

4 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be  
5 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are  
6 residents of this state. Such persons must present an  
7 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a  
8 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with  
9 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend  
10 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the  
11 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and  
12 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the  
13 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red  
14 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design  
15 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other  
16 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each  
17 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

18 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall  
19 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any  
20 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars  
21 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of  
22 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans  
23 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed  
24 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

1           21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
2 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the  
3 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and  
4 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert  
5 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity  
6 of one (1) ton or less;

7           22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be  
8 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of  
9 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may  
10 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle  
11 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

12           23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates  
13 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor  
14 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in  
15 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

16           24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air  
18 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate  
19 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
20 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license  
21 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

22           25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
23 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for  
24 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-

1 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with  
2 the Ninety-Nines;

3 26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall  
4 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.  
5 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend  
6 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the  
7 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".  
8 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate  
9 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
10 less;

11 27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall  
12 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member  
13 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United  
14 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat  
15 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
16 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

17 28. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be  
18 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of  
19 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for  
20 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall  
21 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

22 29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such  
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state  
24

1 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the  
2 United States Secretary of Defense;

3 30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be  
4 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
5 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any  
6 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as  
7 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such  
8 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
9 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
11 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate  
12 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the  
13 district number;

14 32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be  
15 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United  
16 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the  
17 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected  
18 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which  
19 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been  
20 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a  
21 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the  
22 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability  
23 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons  
24 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license

1 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no  
2 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying  
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any  
4 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or  
5 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or  
6 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and  
7 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans  
8 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one  
9 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The  
10 fee provided by this section for the special license plate  
11 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other  
12 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees  
13 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this  
14 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

15 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate  
16 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the  
17 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be  
18 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also  
19 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized  
20 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled  
21 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the  
22 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to  
23 the Tax Commission;

1 33. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such  
2 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force  
3 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show  
4 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be  
5 designed in consultation with the Association;

6 34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such  
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state  
8 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons  
9 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for  
10 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.  
11 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the  
12 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the  
13 Academy;

14 35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall  
15 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's  
16 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal  
17 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor  
18 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been  
19 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.  
20 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle  
21 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such  
22 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax  
23 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have  
24 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call

1 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications  
2 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All  
3 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on  
4 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for  
5 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee  
6 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other  
7 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant  
8 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license  
9 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio  
10 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall  
11 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any  
12 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The  
13 right to such special identification plates herein provided for  
14 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the  
15 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

16 36. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for  
18 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license  
19 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of  
20 Oklahoma;

21 37. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be  
22 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or  
23 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for  
24 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or

1 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county  
2 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the  
3 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which  
4 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.  
5 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of  
6 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to  
7 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be  
8 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this  
9 state;

10 38. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates  
11 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of  
12 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"  
13 shall mean:

- 14 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the  
15 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the  
16 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result  
17 of the performance of duties for any branch of the  
18 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard  
19 while on active military duty, or
- 20 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the  
21 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the  
22 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of  
23 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance  
24 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death

1                    occurred while on active duty or after the honorable  
2                    discharge of such person.

3            The fee provided by this section for the special license plate  
4 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other  
5 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees  
6 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

7            39. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates  
8 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has  
9 been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States  
10 Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense  
11 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

13            40. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be  
14 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.  
15 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide  
16 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The  
17 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th  
18 Infantry;

19            41. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such  
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or  
21 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in  
22 Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation  
23 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
24 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1           42. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates -  
2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this  
3 state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.  
4 Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus  
5 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one  
6 (1) ton or less;

7           43. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License Plate - such  
8 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or  
9 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in  
10 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The  
11 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military  
12 Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an  
13 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle  
14 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

15           44. Military Multi-Decoration License Plate - such plates shall  
16 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member  
17 of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for more than one  
18 military decoration license plate pursuant to the provisions of this  
19 section. The Tax Commission shall develop and implement a system  
20 whereby the designs of the eligible license plates can be included  
21 together on a single license plate. Such person may apply for a  
22 Military Multi-Decoration license plate for each vehicle with a  
23 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1           45. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License Plate - such  
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or  
3 present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a  
4 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate  
5 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute  
6 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.  
7 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary  
8 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one  
9 (1) ton or less;

10           46. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such  
11 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting  
12 proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans  
13 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that  
14 such resident has been awarded the Legion of Merit military  
15 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient  
16 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one  
17 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in  
18 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

19           47. 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for  
20 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or  
21 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such  
22 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership  
23 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license  
24 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 1-179th Infantry;

1 48. 2-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for  
2 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or  
3 former member of the 2-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such  
4 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership  
5 association with the 2-179th Infantry Association. The license  
6 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 2-179th Infantry;

7 49. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates  
8 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon  
9 who present proper certification from the United States Department  
10 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action  
11 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat  
12 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated  
13 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

14 50. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License Plate - such plates  
15 shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a United  
16 States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of Defense  
17 form 214 or other documentation certifying such service. Such  
18 persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans license plate  
19 for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less. The  
20 license plate design shall include both gold and silver dolphins to  
21 represent both officer and enlisted service members; ~~and~~

22 51. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License  
23 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably  
24 discharged or present member of the United States Navy Seabees or

1 Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a United States  
2 Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate for vehicles  
3 having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The  
4 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military  
5 Department of the State of Oklahoma; and

6 52. Combat Action Badge Recipient License Plates - such plates  
7 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Badge who  
8 present proper certification from the United States Army. The  
9 license plate shall include the Combat Action Badge earned by the  
10 recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat Action Badge  
11 Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying  
12 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle; provided, the  
13 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the  
14 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to  
15 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate.

16 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such  
17 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to  
18 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License  
19 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma  
20 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration  
21 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
