6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state employee compensation;
8 amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 840-2.16, which
9 relates to minimum annualized salary; modifying
10 employees included in minimum annualized salary;
11 modifying certain minimum annualized salary amount;
12 providing an effective date; and declaring an
13 emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 840-2.16, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 840-2.16. Except as otherwise provided by law, any
18 ~~classified, unclassified or exempt~~ employee of the state, excluding
19 members of boards and commissions, institutions under the
20 administrative authority of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher
21 Education, employees of public school districts and elected
22 officials, on July 1 of each year, earning less than the amount
23 established in the Federal Poverty Guidelines for a ~~three-person~~
24 four-person household, issued each year in the Federal Register by
the United States Department of Health and Human Services, shall

1 receive the necessary grade or salary adjustment to provide for a
2 minimum annualized salary equal to the amount established in the
3 Federal Poverty Guidelines for a ~~three-person~~ four-person household,
4 issued each year in the Federal Register by the United States
5 Department of Health and Human Services. Any ~~classified,~~
6 ~~unclassified or exempt~~ employee of the state, excluding members of
7 boards and commissions, institutions under the administrative
8 authority of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education,
9 employees of public school districts and elected officials, employed
10 after July 1, ~~2007~~ 2019, shall receive a minimum annualized salary
11 equal to the amount established in the Federal Poverty Guidelines
12 for a ~~three-person~~ four-person household, issued each year in the
13 Federal Register by the United States Department of Health and Human
14 Services. This section shall not apply to those persons employed
15 pursuant to paragraph 8 and paragraph 12 of subsection A of Section
16 840-5.5 and Section 2241 of this title or those persons employed
17 pursuant to Section 1.6a of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
