6 An Act relating to schools; directing the State
7 Department of Education, in certain collaboration, to
8 make certain information regarding workplace safety
9 training available to school districts; directing the
10 State Department of Education to encourage school
11 districts to inform certain teachers about the
12 importance of certain incorporation; directing
13 promulgation of rules; providing for codification;
14 providing an effective date; and declaring an
15 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.6j of Title 70, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. The State Department of Education, in collaboration with the
21 Oklahoma Department of Labor, shall make available to school
22 districts information regarding workplace safety training for grades
23 seven through twelve. Such information shall include the Oklahoma
24 Department of Labor's "Youth @ Work Talking Safety: A Safety and
25 Health Curriculum for Young Workers".

26 B. The State Department of Education shall encourage school
27 districts to inform grade-seven through -twelve teachers about the

1 importance of incorporating workplace safety training in their
2 curriculum.

3 C. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to
4 implement the provisions of this act.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
