9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
10	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 65 of Title 73, unless there is
12	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
13	A. In keeping with the tradition established by the display of
14	the national motto in the Tourist Information Center of the United
15	States Capitol Building, the Director of the Office of Management
16	and Enterprise Services shall utilize monies from the Oklahoma State
17	Capitol Building Repair and Restoration Fund to create an
18	inscription of the national motto of the United States in a
19	prominently visible location in the visitor center of the Oklahoma
20	State Capitol Building. The placement and size of the display shall
21	be in keeping with the placement and size of the display of the
22	national motto in the Tourist Information Center of the United
23	States Capitol Building.

1	B. In the event that the legality or constitutionality of the
2	inscription is challenged in a court of law, the Oklahoma Attorney
3	General is hereby authorized to prepare and present a legal defense
4	of the inscription.
5	C. The placement of this inscription shall not be construed to
6	mean that the State of Oklahoma favors any particular religion or
7	denomination thereof over others.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
