NEW LAW 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-149.3 of Title 70, unless 16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 Subject to the availability of funds, each school district 18 in this state shall have a panic button alert system. The panic 19 button alert system shall: 20 1. Connect the caller with 911 emergency responders while 21 simultaneously notifying designated school district personnel; 22 2. Be available for use as a smartphone application and have a 23 mechanism for panic notifications to be triggered by non-smartphone

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wireless callers and landline callers; and

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- 3. Be limited to users designated, approved and confirmed by school administrators.
- B. Subject to the availability of funds, the Oklahoma School Security Institute shall provide a way for a public school to geofence the school campus and provide and manage floor plans and other documents to assist emergency responders. For the purpose of this section, "geo-fence" means the creation of a virtual geographic boundary by means of global positioning system or radio-frequency identification technology enabling software.
- C. Subject to the availability of funds, the Oklahoma School Security Institute shall provide panic button alert system training to personnel designated pursuant to subsection A of this section.

 The training shall allow participants to:
- 1. Discuss simulated emergency situations in a low-stress environment;
- 2. Clarify the roles and responsibilities of individuals and the logistics of handling an emergency on the school campus; and
- 3. Identify areas in which modifications should be made to the written plans and procedures adopted by the district as required by Section 681 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

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1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
