19	the pay and allowances of their grade all benefits in accordance
20	with the provisions of the Oklahoma Administrative Workers'
21	Compensation Act, Section 1 et seq. of Title 85A of the Oklahoma
22	Statutes, during the period that they are unable to resume their
23	civilian occupation; but no commissioned officer shall be paid after

        All payments herein provided for shall be paid on the approval
    of the Adjutant General by warrant drawn against the funds

        In the event of compensation for said service, death or

    injuries, being paid in part by the federal government, the state

    shall pay only the balance necessary to make the above designated
