6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to Oklahoma National Guard; amending  
8 44 O.S. 2011, Section 75, which relates to hospital  
9 and medical treatment; establishing eligibility for  
10 workers' compensation benefits under certain  
11 circumstances; modifying requirements for certain  
12 payments; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 2011, Section 75, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 75. ~~Officers and/or enlisted men~~ Military personnel who  
17 suffer injuries or contract disease, in line of duty, while on ~~duty~~  
18 ~~or in active service~~ State Active Duty pursuant to Section 72 of  
19 this title, shall receive ~~hospitalization and medical treatment, and~~  
20 ~~the pay and allowances of their grade~~ all benefits in accordance  
21 with the provisions of the Oklahoma Administrative Workers'  
22 Compensation Act, Section 1 et seq. of Title 85A of the Oklahoma  
23 Statutes, during the period that they are unable to resume their  
24 civilian occupation; ~~but no commissioned officer shall be paid after~~

1 ~~the termination of said service or duty more than the pay and~~  
2 ~~allowances of a Second Lieutenant.~~

3 ~~All payments herein provided for shall be paid on the approval~~  
4 ~~of the Adjutant General by warrant drawn against the funds~~  
5 ~~appropriated for that purpose in the Military Department or other~~  
6 ~~funds made available.~~

7 In the event of compensation for said service, death or  
8 injuries, being paid in part by the federal government, the state  
9 shall pay only the balance necessary to make the above designated  
10 amounts.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
