6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the right to bear arms; creating  
8 the 2nd Amendment Preservation Act; providing short  
9 title; providing penalties for certain violations;  
10 providing for codification; and declaring an  
11 emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1290.28 of Title 21, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "2nd  
17 Amendment Preservation Act".

18 B. Any official, agent or employee of the United States  
19 government or any employee of a corporation providing services to  
20 the United States government who enforces or attempts to enforce an  
21 act, order, law, statute, rule or regulation of the government of  
22 the United States in violation of this act shall be guilty of a  
23 felony and shall, upon conviction, be punished by imprisonment in  
24 the custody of the Department of Corrections not to exceed five (5)

1 years, or by a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00),  
2 or by both such fine and imprisonment.

3 C. Any public officer or employee of the State of Oklahoma or  
4 any political subdivision of the state who enforces or attempts to  
5 enforce an act, order, law, statute, rule or regulation of the  
6 government of the United States in violation of this act shall be  
7 guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction, be punished by  
8 imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed two (2) years, or by a  
9 fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such  
10 fine and imprisonment.

11 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
