10	for filling vacancy in office of United States Senator; requiring certain appointment; providing for
11	special elections; specifying certain duties of Governor; updating statutory language; and providing
12	an effective date.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 51 O.S. 2011, Section 10, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 10. A. All vacancies in state offices, except in
18	offices of the members of the Legislature, and members of the House
19	of Representatives from Oklahoma in the Congress of the United
20	States of America and members of the Senate of the United States of
21	America, shall be filled by appointment by the Governor. When a
22	vacancy occurs in the office of district judge, associate district
23	judge, or judge of any intermediate appellate court, the Governor
24 27	shall, in filling such vacancy, utilize the services of the Judicial

1	Nominating Commission in the manner as provided for in the filling
2	of judicial offices under Section 4, Article 7B of the Oklahoma
3	Constitution. When a vacancy occurs in the office of a member of
4	the United States Senate from Oklahoma, the Governor shall call a
5	special election to fill such vacancy, which shall be held
6	concurrently with the next regularly scheduled statewide Primary,
7	Runoff Primary and General Elections, and shall appoint a person to
8	serve in such office until a successor is elected. If such vacancy
9	occurs on a date within thirty (30) days of the filing period for
10	such election cycle and prior to the date of the general election,
11	the special election to fill the vacancy shall be held concurrently
12	with the next succeeding regularly scheduled statewide Primary,
13	Runoff Primary and General Elections.

14 All vacancies in county offices except the board of county в. 15 commissioners or except for any elective county office of any county 16 in the State of Oklahoma having a population of more than six 17 hundred thousand (600,000), according to the latest Federal 18 Decennial Census shall be filled by appointment by the board of 19 county commissioners. If such an appointment is made prior to the 20 prescribed filing period for county officers in accordance with the 21 provisions of Section 131 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the 22 county commissioners shall, at the time said the appointment is 23 made, proclaim a special election to fill the balance of the 24 unexpired term, providing the balance of the term does not expire in \_ \_

1 the year following the next succeeding general election. In making 2 the proclamation, the county commissioners shall establish the dates 3 for the filing period, primary election, runoff primary election and 4 general election to be the same as the next succeeding filing 5 period, primary election, runoff primary election and general 6 election for county officers. The appointee shall be eligible to 7 become a candidate at said the special election, providing said the 8 appointee is otherwise qualified. The office to be filled shall be 9 printed on the same ballot as other county offices.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 12-101, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 3, O.S.L. 2012 (26 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 12-101), is amended to read as follows:

Section 12-101. A. Except as otherwise provided by law, whenever a vacancy shall occur in the office of a member of the United States Senate or United States House of Representatives from Oklahoma, such vacancy shall be filled at a Special Election to be called by the Governor within thirty (30) days after such vacancy occurs.

B. No special election shall be called if the vacancy occurs in an even-numbered year if the term of the office expires the following year. In such case, the candidate elected to the office at the regular General Election shall be appointed by the Governor to fill the unexpired term.
