13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 5-112, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 5-112. A. A declaration of candidacy must be
16	accompanied by:
17	1. A petition supporting a candidate's filing signed by not
18	fewer than two percent (2%) of the number of registered voters in
19	the district, county or state, as appropriate for the office sought;

21	2. A a cashier's check, or certified check, or petition
22	supporting a candidate's filing as follows:

1 for 1. For candidates for Governor, Two Thousand Dollars 2 (\$2,000.00), or a petition signed by four thousand (4,000)3 registered voters within the state; 4 for 2. For candidates for United States Senator, Two 5 Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00), or a petition signed by four thousand 6 (4,000) registered voters within the state; 7 for 3. For candidates for United States Congress, One 8 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or a petition signed by two thousand 9 (2,000) registered voters within the congressional district; 10 for 4. For candidates for Lieutenant Governor, 11 Corporation Commission, Attorney General, State Auditor and 12 Inspector, State Superintendent of Public Instruction, State 13 Treasurer, Commissioner of Insurance and Commissioner of Labor, One 14 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or a petition signed by two thousand 15 (2,000) registered voters within the state; 16 for 5. For candidates for the State House of 17 Representatives, Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or a petition 18 signed by one thousand (1,000) registered voters within the State 19 House district; 20 for 6. For candidates for the State Senate, Seven Hundred 21 Fifty Dollars (\$750.00), or a petition signed by one thousand five 22 hundred (1,500) registered voters within the State Senate district; 23 for 7. For candidates for District Judge or Associate 24 District Judge, Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or a petition signed

1	by one thousand (1,000) registered voters within the judicial
2	district;
3	h. for <u>8. For</u> candidates for District Attorney, Five Hundred
4	Dollars (\$500.00), or a petition signed by one thousand (1,000)

6	i. for <u>9. For</u> candidates for <u>any other</u> county office, Three
7	Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), or a petition signed by six hundred (600)
8	registered voters within the county.
9	B. A filing fee received by the Secretary of the State Election
10	Board shall be deposited in the State Election Board Revolving Fund
11	created pursuant to Section 3-107 of this title. A filing fee
12	received by a secretary of a county election board shall be
13	deposited in the County Election Board Special Depository Account
14	authorized by Section 3-108 of this title.
15	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
