12 ~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 150.9.1 of Title 74, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma Department of Human
17 Services and Oklahoma Employment Security Commission shall be
18 authorized to require agency employees in positions that have access
19 to Federal Tax Information and data to supply all information and
20 documentation required in order to be subjected to a criminal
21 history search by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, as
22 well as be fingerprinted for submission of the fingerprints through
23 the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to the Federal Bureau of
24 Investigation for a national criminal history check. The applicable

1 employer-agency shall be the recipient of the results of the record
2 check. In accordance with Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
3 Statutes, this includes a national criminal record with a
4 fingerprint analysis.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
