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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public finance; requiring Office
8 of Management and Enterprise Services to prepare and
9 make available certain report utilizing specified
10 information; providing for contents of report;
11 defining terms; providing for codification; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.42.2 of Title 62, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
18 utilize information disclosed by agencies pursuant to Section
19 34.42.1 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes to prepare a "Coercive
20 Federal Funds Report" which applies to funds received by each
21 agency. The report shall be made available on a website maintained
22 by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. The report
23 shall include a detailed description of:

24 1. Each source of federal funds received by an agency in excess
of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in the aggregate; and

1 2. The conditions that must be met for continued eligibility
2 for each fund source, based on relevant federal law, regulations and
3 guidance. The description of conditions attached to each source
4 shall be clearly separated into the following categories:

- 5 a. conditions that describe the manner in which the
6 federal funds must be spent,
- 7 b. conditions that describe the manner in which any
8 related nonfederal, state or local funds must be spent
9 including "maintenance of effort" and similar
10 requirements, and
- 11 c. conditions that relate to policy matters other than
12 the manner in which federal, state or local funds must
13 be spent including requirements that state regulations
14 meet or exceed the stringency of federal regulations.

15 B. For the purposes of this section, the conditions described
16 in subparagraphs b and c of paragraph 2 of subsection A of this
17 section shall be defined as "coercive federal conditions" and the
18 related federal funds shall be defined as "coercive federal funds".

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.

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
