of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in the aggregate; and

1. Each source of federal funds received by an agency in excess

- 2. The conditions that must be met for continued eligibility for each fund source, based on relevant federal law, regulations and guidance. The description of conditions attached to each source shall be clearly separated into the following categories:
 - a. conditions that describe the manner in which the federal funds must be spent,
 - b. conditions that describe the manner in which any related nonfederal, state or local funds must be spent including "maintenance of effort" and similar requirements, and
 - c. conditions that relate to policy matters other than the manner in which federal, state or local funds must be spent including requirements that state regulations meet or exceed the stringency of federal regulations.
- B. For the purposes of this section, the conditions described in subparagraphs b and c of paragraph 2 of subsection A of this section shall be defined as "coercive federal conditions" and the related federal funds shall be defined as "coercive federal funds".

 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
