



1 small farm winery's products, both the selling winery and the buying  
2 winery shall be small farm winery permit holders;

3 3. To serve free samples of wine produced by the licensee to  
4 visitors twenty-one (21) years of age or older;

5 4. To sell wines produced by that small farm winery for either  
6 on-premises or off-premises consumption to consumers on the small  
7 farm winery premises, or premises located contiguous thereto;

8 5. To sell wine at public events such as trade shows or  
9 festivals; and

10 6. To also hold a mixed beverage license, beer and wine license  
11 or caterer's license.

12 B. A small farm wine may display the trademarked "Oklahoma  
13 Grown" sticker available from the Oklahoma Grape Industry Council.

14 C. For purposes of subsection A of this section, no visitor may  
15 sample more than a total of six (6) fluid ounces of wine per day.

16 The small farm winery shall restrict the distribution and  
17 consumption of wine samples to an area within the licensed premises  
18 designated by the small farm winery. A current floor plan that  
19 includes the designated sampling area must be on file with the ABLE  
20 Commission. No visitor under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be  
21 permitted to enter this designated sampling area when samples are  
22 being distributed or consumed. Samples of wine served by a small  
23 farm winery under this section shall not be considered a sale of  
24 wine within the meaning of Article XXVIII A of the Oklahoma

1 Constitution or Section 1-103 of this title; however, such samples  
2 of wine shall be considered wine removed or withdrawn from the small  
3 farm winery for use or consumption for excise tax determination and  
4 reporting requirements.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 2018.
