Any person in this state who shall steal any 14 15 horse, jackass, jennet, mule, cow, hog, or implement of husbandry, as defined in Section 1-125 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, 16 shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction shall be punished by 17 confinement in the State Penitentiary Department of Corrections for 18 a term of not less than three (3) years, nor more than ten (10) 19 years; and any person in this state who shall steal any dog, sheep, 20 or goat, shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction therefor 21 shall be punished by confinement in the State Penitentiary 22 Department of Corrections for a term not less than six (6) months, 23 nor more than three (3) years, or by a fine in an amount that is 24

1 equal to three times the value of animals and machinery that were stolen but not more than Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) 2 3 Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment. The word "horse" as used in this section 4 5 includes all animals of the equine species and the word "cow" 6 includes all animals of bovine species. 7 B. If the court elects not to sentence the defendant to confinement in the Department of Corrections pursuant to subsection 8 9 A of this section, the court may sentence the defendant to 10 confinement in the county jail for a term not less than six (6) 11 months nor more than one (1) year. SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 12 13 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 14 15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24
