12	An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1716, which relates to the

18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1716, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	Section 1716. A. Any person in this state who shall steal any
22	horse, jackass, jennet, mule, cow, hog, or implement of husbandry,
23	as defined in Section 1-125 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes
24	shall <del>be guilty of a felony and</del> , upon conviction <del>shall be punished</del> ,

1	be guilty of a felony punishable by confinement in the State
2	Penitentiary custody of the Department of Corrections for a term of
3	not less than three (3) years, nor more than ten (10) fifteen (15)
4	years; and any, and by restitution in an amount that is equal to
5	three times the value of the animals or implement of husbandry that
6	was stolen.
7	B. Any person in this state who shall steal any dog, sheep, or
8	goat, shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony and upon
9	conviction therefor shall be punished punishable by confinement in
10	the <del>State Penitentiary</del> <u>custody of the Department of Corrections</u> for
11	a term $\underline{\text{of}}$ not less than six (6) months, nor more than three (3)
12	years, or and by a fine restitution in an amount that is equal to
13	three times the value of <u>the</u> animals <del>and machinery</del> that were stolen
14	but not more than Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), or by

C. Two-thirds (2/3) of the restitution collected in subsection A or B of this section shall be paid to the owner of the animal or implement of husbandry and one-third (1/3) of the restitution collected shall be paid to the State Department of Agriculture Revolving Fund and shall be utilized solely for the benefit of the agriculture law enforcement agents commissioned pursuant to the provisions of Section 6-310 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

2	shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as a
