12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 4254, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 4254. <u>A.</u> No state officer or state employee shall
16	receive any additional compensation or reimbursement from any person
17	for personally engaging in lobbying other than compensation or
18	reimbursements provided by law for that member's job position.
19	B. No former state employee or employee of any political
20	subdivision of this state shall be employed as a lobbyist or
21	otherwise receive any compensation or reimbursement from any person
22	for personally engaging in lobbying for a period of not less than
23	two (2) years from the date of the end of service as a public
24	employee.

1	C. No former state employee or employee of any political
2	subdivision shall be permitted to be employed by, or otherwise
3	receive any compensation or reimbursement from, any entity which
4	received more than twenty percent (20%) of its annual revenues from
5	the state or political subdivision in the two (2) immediately
6	preceding fiscal years, if the employee influenced or could
7	reasonably have been perceived to have influenced the receipt of
8	such revenue by the employing entity. This prohibition shall be
9	effective for a period of two (2) years from the date of the end of
10	service as a public employee. The provisions of this subsection
11	shall not apply if the employee was responsible only for payment
12	processing or other ministerial duties with respect to such revenue.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
