12	an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1600, as
17	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 257, O.S.L. 2016 (69 O.S. Supp.
18	2016, Section 1600), is amended to read as follows:
19	Section 1600. A. The cost associated with signage related to
20	the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway system shall
21	be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign. The
22	provisions of this section shall not apply to the naming of highways
23	and bridges on the state highway system designed to honor members of
24	the United States Armed Forces who were killed while participating

The Department of Transportation shall promulgate rules establishing a procedure to assess and collect the cost of the 2 The assessment of cost shall include the cost of the initial 3 signs. erection of the sign as well as the potential replacement or 4 5 reconstruction of the sign. The cost of these signs shall be based on an average of the cost of signs erected during the preceding 6 fiscal year, as reported by the Department of Transportation. 7 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 12, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 8 9 2013, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 61, O.S.L. 2015 (69 O.S. 10 Supp. 2016, Section 1600.1), is amended to read as follows: Section 1600.1. Highways, bridges, and other facilities which 11 are part of the state highway system may be considered for 12 dedication in honor of individuals deserving of commendation for 13 their active involvement in the project or for outstanding service 14 to the nation, this state, or their community. Persons proposed to 15 be so honored shall have been deceased not less than three (3) years 16 prior to consideration. The provisions of this section shall not 17 apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway 18 system designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces $_{T}$ 19 members of law enforcement or firefighters fallen in the performance 20 of their duties or emergency first responders as defined by Section 21 1600 of this title. The provisions of this section shall also not 22 apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway 23 system designed to honor Medal of Honor recipients both living and 24

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1	deceased. Proposals for the dedication of state highway facilities
2	should specifically state the accomplishments upon which the
3	proposal is based.
4	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
5	SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
