6 [Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act -
7 issuance of special or personalized license plates -
8 combination of registration periods - single
9 remittance of specified fees - effective date]
10

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1116, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1116. A. Twelve registration periods shall be
15 established for vehicles required to be registered on a staggered
16 basis. The registration periods shall start on the first day of
17 each calendar month and shall end on the last day of that month.
18 Unless otherwise provided, all such vehicles where the date of
19 execution of transfer of ownership occurs in this state at any time
20 during a calendar month shall be subject to registration and payment
21 of the fee for the registration period commencing the first day of
22 the month of such date of execution of transfer.

23 B. A person who registers more than one vehicle may have all of
24 such vehicles initially registered at the same time or at separate

1 times. Any person who obtains a vehicle may, upon registration,
2 have the registration period adjusted to allow future registration
3 of all such vehicles at the same period or at a different period.

4 C. On and after January 1, 2022, if a special or personalized
5 license plate is issued pursuant to this title for a vehicle which
6 is subject to the requirements of Section 1132 of this title, the
7 registration periods for the vehicle may be combined into a single
8 registration period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall determine,
9 by rule, a method for adjusting the twelve-month period.

10 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1132, as
11 amended by Section 2, Chapter 337, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020,
12 Section 1132), is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 1132. A. For all vehicles, unless otherwise
14 specifically provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
15 Registration Act, a registration fee shall be assessed at the time
16 of initial registration by the owner and annually thereafter, for
17 the use of the avenues of public access within this state in the
18 following amounts:

19 1. For the first through the fourth year of registration in
20 this state or any other state, Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00);

21 2. For the fifth through the eighth year of registration in
22 this state or any other state, Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00);

23 3. For the ninth through the twelfth year of registration in
24 this state or any other state, Fifty-five Dollars (\$55.00);

1 4. For the thirteenth through the sixteenth year of
2 registration in this state or any other state, Thirty-five Dollars
3 (\$35.00); and

4 5. For the seventeenth and any following year of registration
5 in this state or any other state, Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00).

6 The registration fee provided for in this subsection shall be in
7 lieu of all other taxes, general or local, unless otherwise
8 specifically provided.

9 On and after January 1, 2022, if a special or personalized
10 license plate is issued pursuant to Sections 1135.1 through 1135.7
11 of this title, any registration fee required for such plate and the
12 fee required pursuant to this subsection shall be remitted at the
13 same time and subject to a single registration period. Upon receipt
14 of a special or personalized plate, the standard issue license plate
15 must be surrendered to the Oklahoma Tax Commission or motor license
16 agent. The special or personalized plate must be properly displayed
17 as required for a standard issue and will be the sole plate
18 issued/assigned to the vehicle. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall
19 determine, by rule, a method for making required fee adjustments
20 when a special or personalized license plate is obtained during a
21 twelve-month period for which a registration fee has already been
22 remitted pursuant to this subsection. The combination of fees in a
23 single remittance shall not alter the apportionment otherwise
24 provided for by law.

1 B. For all-terrain vehicles and motorcycles used exclusively
2 for use off roads or highways purchased on or after July 1, 2005,
3 and for all-terrain vehicles and motorcycles used exclusively for
4 use off roads or highways purchased prior to July 1, 2005, which the
5 owner chooses to register pursuant to the provisions of Section
6 1115.3 of this title, an initial and nonrecurring registration fee
7 of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) shall be assessed at the time of initial
8 registration by the owner. Nine Dollars (\$9.00) of the registration
9 fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement
10 Fund. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of the registration fee shall be retained
11 by the motor license agent. The fees required by subsection A of
12 this section shall not be required for all-terrain vehicles or
13 motorcycles used exclusively off roads and highways.

14 C. For utility vehicles used exclusively for use off roads or
15 highways purchased on or after July 1, 2008, and for utility
16 vehicles used exclusively for use off roads or highways purchased
17 prior to July 1, 2008, which the owner chooses to register pursuant
18 to the provisions of Section 1115.3 of this title, an initial and
19 nonrecurring registration fee of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) shall be
20 assessed at the time of initial registration by the owner. Nine
21 Dollars (\$9.00) of the registration fee shall be deposited in the
22 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of
23 the registration fee shall be retained by the motor license agent.
24 The fees required by subsection A of this section shall not be

1 required for utility vehicles used exclusively off roads and
2 highways.

3 D. There shall be a credit allowed with respect to the fee for
4 registration of a new vehicle which is a replacement for:

5 1. A new original vehicle which is stolen from the
6 purchaser/registrant within ninety (90) days of the date of purchase
7 of the original vehicle as certified by a police report or other
8 documentation as required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission; or

9 2. A defective new original vehicle returned by the
10 purchaser/registrant to the seller within six (6) months of the date
11 of purchase of the defective new original vehicle as certified by
12 the manufacturer.

13 The credit shall be in the amount of the fee for registration
14 which was paid for the new original vehicle and shall be applied to
15 the registration fee for the replacement vehicle. In no event will
16 the credit be refunded.

17 E. Upon every transfer or change of ownership of a vehicle, the
18 new owner shall obtain title for and, except in the case of salvage
19 vehicles and manufactured homes, register the vehicle within thirty
20 (30) days of change of ownership and pay a transfer fee of Fifteen
21 Dollars (\$15.00) in addition to any other fees provided for in ~~this~~
22 ~~act~~ the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. No new decal
23 shall be issued to the registrant. Thereafter, the owner shall
24 register the vehicle annually on the anniversary date of its initial

1 registration in this state and shall pay the fees provided in
2 subsection A of this section and receive a decal evidencing such
3 payment. Provided, used motor vehicle dealers shall be exempt from
4 the provisions of this section.

5 F. In the event a new or used vehicle is not registered, titled
6 and tagged within thirty (30) days from the date of transfer of
7 ownership, the penalty for the failure of the owner of the vehicle
8 to register the vehicle within thirty (30) days shall be One Dollar
9 (\$1.00) per day, provided that in no event shall the penalty exceed
10 One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). No penalty shall be waived by the
11 Oklahoma Tax Commission or any motor license agent except as
12 provided in subsection C of Section 1127 of this title. Of each
13 dollar penalty collected pursuant to this subsection:

14 1. Twenty-one cents (\$0.21) shall be apportioned as provided in
15 Section 1104 of this title;

16 2. Twenty-one cents (\$0.21) shall be retained by the motor
17 license agent; and

18 3. Fifty-eight cents (\$0.58) shall be deposited in the General
19 Revenue Fund.

20 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.1, as
21 amended by Section 1, Chapter 26, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020,
22 Section 1135.1), is amended to read as follows:
23

1 Section 1135.1. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
2 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
3 plates to persons as provided by this section.

4 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
5 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
6 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
7 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
8 registered for the current year.

9 Except as provided in subsection B of this section, special
10 license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a
11 motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall annually notify by
12 mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall
13 contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for
14 the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or
15 the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a
16 staggered system. The motor license agent fees shall be paid out of
17 the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

18 On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is
19 issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for
20 such plate pursuant to this section and the fee required pursuant to
21 Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at the same time and
22 subject to a single registration period. The Oklahoma Tax
23 Commission shall determine, by rule, a method for making required
24 fee and registration period adjustments if a special license plate

1 is obtained during a twelve-month period for which a registration
2 fee has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132 of this
3 title. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall not
4 alter the apportionment otherwise provided for in this section.

5 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
6 follows:

7 1. Political Subdivision Plates - such plates shall be designed
8 for any vehicle owned by any political subdivision of this state
9 having obtained a proper Oklahoma certificate of title. Such
10 political subdivisions shall file an annual report with the Tax
11 Commission stating the agency where such vehicle is located. Such
12 license plates shall be permanent in nature and designed in such a
13 manner as to remain with the vehicle for the duration of the life
14 span of the vehicle or until the title is transferred to an owner
15 who is not a political subdivision.

16 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be
17 in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except
18 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

19 2. Tax-Exempt or Nonprofit License Plates - such plates shall
20 be designed for:

21 a. any motor bus, manufactured home, or mobile chapel and
22 power unit owned and operated by a religious
23 corporation or society of this state holding a valid
24 exemption from taxation issued pursuant to Section

1 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C.,
2 Section 501(a), and listed as an exempt organization
3 in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as
4 amended, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), and that is
5 used by the corporation or society solely for the
6 furtherance of its religious functions,

7 b. any vehicle owned and operated only by nonprofit
8 organizations devoted exclusively to youth programs
9 including, but not limited to, the Girl Scouts and Boy
10 Scouts of America,

11 c. any vehicle, except passenger automobiles, owned or
12 operated by nonprofit organizations actually involved
13 in programs for the employment of the handicapped and
14 used exclusively in the transportation of goods or
15 materials for such organization,

16 d. any vehicle owned and operated by a nonprofit
17 organization that provides older persons
18 transportation to and from medical, dental and
19 religious services and relief from business and social
20 isolation,

21 e. any vehicle owned and operated by a private nonprofit
22 organization that:

23 (1) warehouses and distributes surplus foods to other
24 nonprofit agencies and organizations, and

1 (2) holds a valid exemption from taxation issued
2 pursuant to Section 501(c) of the Internal
3 Revenue Code, as amended, 26 U.S.C., Section
4 501(c), and listed as an exempt organization in
5 Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code,
6 as amended, and

7 (3) uses such vehicle exclusively for the
8 transportation of such surplus foods,

9 f. any vehicle which:

10 (1) is owned and operated by a private, nonprofit
11 organization which is exempt from taxation
12 pursuant to the provisions of Section 501(c)(3)
13 of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section
14 501(c)(3), and which is primarily funded by a
15 fraternal or civic service organization with at
16 least one hundred local chapters or clubs, and

17 (2) is designed and used to provide mobile health
18 screening services to the general public at no
19 cost to the recipient, and for which no
20 reimbursement of any kind is received from any
21 health insurance provider, health maintenance
22 organization or governmental program, or

23 g. any vehicle owned and operated by the Civil Air
24 Patrol, a congressionally chartered corporation that

1 also serves an auxiliary of the United States Air
2 Force and which is exempt from taxation pursuant to
3 the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
4 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), and is
5 used exclusively for its corporate missions of
6 aerospace education, cadet programs and emergency
7 services. Such license plates shall be permanent in
8 nature and designed in such a manner as to remain with
9 the vehicle for the duration of the life span of the
10 vehicle or until the title to such vehicle is
11 transferred to an owner who is not subject to this
12 exemption. Such vehicles shall be exempt from the
13 registration fees levied under Section 1132 of this
14 title, except that an initial registration fee of
15 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) shall apply to each
16 vehicle.

17 Any person claiming to be eligible for a tax-exempt or nonprofit
18 license plate under the provisions of this paragraph must have the
19 name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit organization prominently
20 displayed upon the outside of the vehicle, except those vehicles
21 registered pursuant to the provisions of subparagraph b of this
22 paragraph, unless such display is prohibited by federal or state law
23 or by state agency rules. No vehicle shall be licensed as a tax-
24 exempt or nonprofit vehicle unless the vehicle has affixed on each

1 side thereof, in letters not less than two (2) inches high and two
2 (2) inches wide, the name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit
3 organization or the insignia or other symbol of such organization
4 which shall be of sufficient size, shape and color as to be readily
5 legible during daylight hours from a distance of fifty (50) feet
6 while the vehicle is not in motion.

7 Except as provided in subparagraph g of this paragraph, the
8 registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in
9 addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the
10 registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

11 3. Physically Disabled License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for persons who are eligible for a physically disabled
13 placard under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title. It
14 shall prominently display the international accessibility symbol,
15 which is a stylized human figure in a wheelchair. The Tax
16 Commission shall also design physically disabled license plates for
17 motorcycles owned by persons who are eligible for a physically
18 disabled placard pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-112 of
19 this title. Upon the death of the physically disabled person, the
20 disabled license plate shall be returned to the Tax Commission.
21 There shall be no fee for such plate in addition to the rate
22 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act for
23 the registration of the vehicle. For an additional fee of Ten
24 Dollars (\$10.00), a person eligible for a physically disabled

1 license plate shall have the option of purchasing a duplicate
2 physically disabled special license plate which shall be securely
3 attached to the front of the vehicle. The original physically
4 disabled special license plate shall be securely attached to the
5 rear of the vehicle at all times.

6 Any person who is eligible for a physically disabled license
7 plate and whose vehicle has had modifications because of the
8 physical disability of the owner or of a family member within the
9 second degree of consanguinity of the owner, may register the
10 vehicle for a flat fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). This fee
11 shall be in lieu of all other registration fees provided by the
12 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

13 4. Indian Tribal License Plates - such plates shall be designed
14 for any vehicle of a native American Indian Tribal Association
15 exempted in Sections 201 through 204 of Public Law 97-473 and used
16 by the tribal association exclusively for the furtherance of its
17 tribal functions.

18 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be
19 in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except
20 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

21 5. Hearing Impaired License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed for persons who are hearing impaired. Such persons may
23 apply for a hearing-impaired license plate for each vehicle with a
24 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon the presentment

1 of an application on a form furnished by the Tax Commission and
2 certified by a physician holding a valid license to practice
3 pursuant to the licensing provisions of Title 59 of the Oklahoma
4 Statutes, attesting that the person is hearing impaired. The
5 license plate shall be designed so that such persons may be readily
6 identified as being hearing impaired. There shall be no additional
7 fee for the plate, but all other registration fees provided by the
8 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act shall apply;

9 6. Antique or Classic Vehicles License Plates - such plates
10 shall be designed and issued for any vehicle twenty-five (25) years
11 of age or older, based upon the date of manufacture thereof and
12 which travels on the highways of this state primarily incidental to
13 historical or exhibition purposes only.

14 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be
15 in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except
16 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. Any
17 person registering an antique or classic vehicle may elect to have
18 the vehicle registered for a ten-year period. The registration fee
19 for the elected ten-year registration shall be Seventy-five Dollars
20 (\$75.00). The motor license agent registering the antique or
21 classic vehicle for a ten-year period shall receive one hundred
22 percent (100%) of the fees the motor license agent would have
23 otherwise received pursuant to subsection A of Section 1141.1 of
24

1 this title if the antique or classic vehicle had been registered on
2 an annual basis; and

3 7. Honorary Consul License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to include the words "Honorary Consul" and issued to
5 persons who are honorary consuls authorized by the United States to
6 perform consular duties. Persons applying for such license plates
7 must show proof of standing as an honorary consul. The fee for such
8 plate shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to all
9 other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
10 Registration Act. The owner of the vehicle that possesses such
11 license plates shall return the special license plates to the
12 Oklahoma Tax Commission if the owner disposes of the vehicle during
13 the registration year or ceases to be authorized to perform consular
14 duties.

15 C. Special license plates provided by this section shall be
16 designed in such a manner as to identify the use or ownership of the
17 vehicle. Use of any vehicle possessing a special license plate
18 provided by this section for any purpose not specified herein shall
19 be grounds for revocation of the special license plate and
20 registration certificate.

21 D. The fees provided by this section shall be deposited in the
22 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
2 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
3 2020, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
6 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
7 provided by this section.

8 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
9 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
10 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
11 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
12 registered for the current year.

13 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
14 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
15 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
16 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
17 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
18 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
19 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
20 amateur radio operator license plates.

21 On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is
22 issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for
23 such plate pursuant to this section and the fee required pursuant to
24 Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at the same time and

1 subject to a single registration period. The Oklahoma Tax
2 Commission shall determine, by rule, a method for making required
3 fee and registration period adjustments if a special license plate
4 is obtained during a twelve-month period for which a registration
5 fee has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132 of this
6 title. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall not
7 alter the apportionment otherwise provided for in this section.

8 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
9 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
10 applications for special license plates authorized under this
11 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
12 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
13 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
14 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
15 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
16 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
17 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
18 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
19 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

20 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
21 follows:

22 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
24 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war

1 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
2 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
3 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
4 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
5 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
6 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
7 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
8 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
9 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
10 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
11 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
12 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

13 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
15 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
16 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
17 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

18 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
20 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
21 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
22 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

23 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed
24 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States

1 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry
2 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
3 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member
4 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably
5 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying
6 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military
7 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or
8 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or
9 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof
10 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
11 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

12 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
13 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
14 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
15 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
16 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
17 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

18 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
20 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
21 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
22 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
23 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
24 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action

1 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
2 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
3 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
4 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
5 of one (1) ton or less;

6 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
8 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
9 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
10 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
11 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
12 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
13 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
14 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
15 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
16 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
17 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
18 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
19 provided by this section for special license plates;

20 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
22 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
23 the United States as being:

24

- 1 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
2 7, 1941,
3 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
4 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
5 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
6 exceed three (3) miles, and
7 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
8 States Armed Forces.

9 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
10 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
11 less;

12 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
13 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
14 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
15 States as being:

- 16 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
17 of 1945,
18 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
19 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
20 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
21 States Armed Forces.

22 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
23 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
24

1 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
2 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
3 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
4 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
5 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
6 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
7 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
8 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
9 registration after the initial issue;

10 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
12 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
13 the United States as being:

- 14 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
15 1944,
- 16 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
17 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
18 participation cannot be verified by the United States
19 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
20 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
21 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
22 the person applying for the license plate, and
- 23 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
24 States Armed Forces.

1 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
2 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
5 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
6 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
7 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
8 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
9 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
10 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
11 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
12 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
13 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
14 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
15 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
16 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

17 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
19 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
20 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
21 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
22 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
23 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
24 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one

1 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
2 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
3 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
4 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

5 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
7 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
8 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
9 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
10 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
11 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

12 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
14 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
15 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
16 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

17 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
19 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
20 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
21 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
22 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
23 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
24 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of

1 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
2 education police department by either an identification card or
3 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
4 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
5 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
6 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
7 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
8 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
9 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
10 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
11 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

12 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
14 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
15 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
16 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
17 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
18 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
19 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
20 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

21 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
22 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
23 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
24 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,

1 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
2 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
3 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
4 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
5 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
6 "WORLD WAR II";

7 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
9 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
10 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
11 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
12 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
13 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
14 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
15 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

16 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
17 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
18 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
19 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
20 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
21 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
22 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
23 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
24 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

1 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
3 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
4 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
5 be produced upon application;

6 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
8 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
9 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
10 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
11 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
12 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
13 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
14 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
15 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
16 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
17 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
18 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
19 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

20 20. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
21 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
22 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
23 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
24

1 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
2 of one (1) ton or less;

3 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
5 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
6 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
7 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
9 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
10 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
11 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

12 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
14 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
15 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
16 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
17 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

18 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
19 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
20 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
21 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
22 the Ninety-Nines;

23 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
24 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.

1 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
2 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
3 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
4 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
5 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
6 less;

7 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
8 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
9 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
10 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
11 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
12 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

13 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
15 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
16 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
17 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

18 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
19 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
20 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
21 United States Secretary of Defense;

22 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
24 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any

1 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
2 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
3 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
4 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

5 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
6 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
7 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
8 district number;

9 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
11 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
12 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
13 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
14 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
15 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
16 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
17 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
18 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
19 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
20 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
21 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
22 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
23 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
24 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or

1 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and
2 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans
3 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
4 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
5 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
6 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
7 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
8 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
9 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

10 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
11 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
12 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
13 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
14 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
15 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
16 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
17 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
18 the Tax Commission;

19 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
21 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
22 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
23 designed in consultation with the Association;

24

1 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
3 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
4 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
5 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
6 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
7 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
8 Academy;

9 34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's
11 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
12 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
13 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
14 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
15 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
16 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
17 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
18 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
19 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
20 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
21 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
22 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on
23 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
24 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee

1 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
2 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
3 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license
4 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
5 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
6 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any
7 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
8 right to such special identification plates herein provided for
9 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
10 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

11 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
13 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
14 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
15 Oklahoma;

16 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
18 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
19 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
20 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
21 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
22 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
23 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
24 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of

1 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
2 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
3 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
4 state;

5 37. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of
7 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
8 shall mean:

- 9 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
10 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
11 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
12 of the performance of duties for any branch of the
13 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
14 while on active military duty, or
- 15 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
16 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
17 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
18 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
19 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
20 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
21 discharge of such person.

22 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate
23 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
24

1 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
2 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

3 38. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has
5 been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States
6 Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense
7 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
8 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 39. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.
11 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide
12 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The
13 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th
14 Infantry;

15 40. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
17 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
18 Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation
19 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated
20 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle;
21 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
22 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
23 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

24

1 41. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates -
2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this
3 state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.
4 Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus
5 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
6 (1) ton or less;

7 42. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License Plate - such
8 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
9 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
10 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The
11 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
12 Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an
13 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle
14 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a
15 motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of
16 similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a
17 new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle
18 license plate;

19 43. Military Multi-Decoration License Plate - such plates shall
20 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
21 of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for more than one
22 military decoration license plate pursuant to the provisions of this
23 section. The Tax Commission shall develop and implement a system
24 whereby the designs of the eligible license plates can be included

1 together on a single license plate. Such person may apply for a
2 Military Multi-Decoration license plate for each vehicle with a
3 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

4 44. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License Plate - such
5 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
6 present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a
7 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate
8 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute
9 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.
10 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary
11 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
12 (1) ton or less;

13 45. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such
14 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting
15 proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans
16 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that
17 such resident has been awarded the Legion of Merit military
18 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient
19 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one
20 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in
21 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

22 46. 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
23 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
24 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such

1 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
2 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license
3 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 1-179th Infantry;

4 47. 2-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
5 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
6 former member of the 2-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
7 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
8 association with the 2-179th Infantry Association. The license
9 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 2-179th Infantry;

10 48. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates
11 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon
12 who present proper certification from the United States Department
13 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action
14 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat
15 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated
16 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

17 49. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a United
19 States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of Defense
20 form 214 or other documentation certifying such service. Such
21 persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans license plate
22 for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
23 license plate design shall include both gold and silver dolphins to
24 represent both officer and enlisted service members;

1 50. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License
2 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably
3 discharged or present member of the United States Navy Seabees or
4 Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a United States
5 Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate for vehicles
6 having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
7 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
8 Department of the State of Oklahoma;

9 51. Combat Action Badge Recipient License Plate - such plates
10 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Badge who
11 present proper certification from the United States Army. The
12 license plate shall include the Combat Action Badge earned by the
13 recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat Action Badge
14 Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying
15 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the
16 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the
17 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to
18 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

19 52. Iraq Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
21 the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation Iraqi
22 Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Iraq Combat Veteran license
23 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
24 or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for

1 motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor
2 vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements
3 for a motorcycle license plate;

4 53. Afghanistan Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
6 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation
7 Enduring Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Afghanistan Combat
8 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
9 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the
10 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the
11 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to
12 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; and

13 54. Special Forces Association - such plates shall be designed
14 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the Army
15 Special Forces qualified and authorized to wear upon the person's
16 United States military uniform the Army Special Forces Tab. Persons
17 applying for the Special Forces Association license plate must
18 provide a copy of the orders awarding the Special Forces Tab or
19 authorizing its wear upon a United States military uniform. The
20 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Special
21 Forces Association, Chapter 32-50. The Tax Commission shall produce
22 up to two distinct designs for the Special Forces Association
23 license plate. Qualified persons may select one design at the time
24 of application. The plates shall be issued to any qualified person

1 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
2 seven, as for personalized license plates.

3 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such
4 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to
5 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License
6 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
7 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration
8 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

9 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
10 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
11 2020, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

12 Section 1135.3. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
13 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
14 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
15 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
16 subject as provided by this section.

17 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
18 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
19 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
20 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
21 registered for the current year.

22 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
23 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
24 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

1 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special
2 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
3 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
4 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
5 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

6 On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is
7 issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for
8 such plate pursuant to this section and the fee required pursuant to
9 Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at the same time and
10 subject to a single registration period. The Oklahoma Tax
11 Commission shall determine, by rule, a method for making required
12 fee and registration period adjustments if a special license plate
13 is obtained during a twelve-month period for which a registration
14 fee has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132 of this
15 title. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall not
16 alter the apportionment otherwise provided for in this section.

17 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
18 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
19 applications for special license plates authorized under this
20 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
21 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
22 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
23 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
24 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents

1 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
2 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
3 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
4 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

5 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
6 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
7 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
8 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
9 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
10 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
11 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
12 removed from the vehicle.

13 Except as otherwise provided in law, for special license plates
14 authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall
15 be developed or issued by the Tax Commission until the Commission
16 receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications therefor. The
17 prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within
18 one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date of the
19 authorization or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In
20 the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are not received by
21 the Tax Commission within such prescribed time period any payment so
22 received shall be refunded accordingly.

23 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
24 follows:

1 1. Round and Square Dance License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 round and square dancing;

4 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
5 License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
6 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
7 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

8 3. National Rifle Association License Plate - such plates shall
9 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
10 Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
11 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
12 Association;

13 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
15 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
16 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
17 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
18 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
19 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
20 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
21 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
22 contain the Masonic emblem;

23 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
24 Plate - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for

1 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
2 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
3 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
4 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
5 contain the Shriner's emblem;

6 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
7 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
8 ballooning in this state;

9 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plate - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
11 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
12 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
13 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
14 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
15 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
16 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
17 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
18 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

19 8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
21 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
22 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
23 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
24 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights

1 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
2 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
3 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
4 Columbus emblem;

5 9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
6 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
7 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
8 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

9 10. Kiwanis International License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
11 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
12 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
13 consultation with Kiwanis International;

14 11. Certified Public Accountants License Plate - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
16 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
17 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
18 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
19 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
20 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
21 Accountants;

22 12. Civil Emergency Management License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
24 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons

1 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
2 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,
3 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
4 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
5 emergency management department head;

6 13. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plate - such plates
7 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
8 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
9 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
10 Conservation Corps;

11 14. Rotarian License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
12 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
13 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license
14 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
15 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
16 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
17 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
18 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
19 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

20 15. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plate - such
21 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
22 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and
23 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the
24 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

1 16. Humane Society License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
4 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
5 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
6 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

7 17. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
9 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this
10 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons
11 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon
12 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.
13 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
14 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
15 personalized license plates;

16 18. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plate - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
18 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
19 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with American Business Clubs;

21 19. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
23 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States
24 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall

1 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
2 Oklahoma;

3 20. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

7 21. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plate - such plates shall
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
9 for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates shall be
10 designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public School System;

11 22. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plate - such
12 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of

2 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
3 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed

7 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa
8 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in

12 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
13 wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities and

17 Incorporated;

18 28. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and
20 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license
21 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department
22 of Health;

23 29. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such
24 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to

1 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.
2 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central
3 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

4 30. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated
5 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
6 wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and Community

20 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support

2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

14 similar design as space permits or a new design in order to meet the

16 73. Air Medal License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
17 issued to Air Medal recipients. An individual requesting the plate
18 is required, at the time of application, to show proof he or she is
19 a recipient of the Air Medal or sign an attestation stating that he

23 74. Oklahoma Institute for Child Advocacy License Plate - such
24 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

1 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Institute for Child Advocacy.
2 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
3 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
4 personalized license plates. The plates shall contain the official
5 Oklahoma Institute for Child Advocacy logo;

6 75. The Pride of Oklahoma Marching Band License Plate - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for the Pride of Oklahoma marching band. The
9 plates shall be designed in consultation with the University of
10 Oklahoma;

11 76. The Spirit of Oklahoma State Marching Band License Plate -
12 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
13 demonstrate support for the Spirit of Oklahoma State marching band.
14 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahoma State
15 University;

16 77. Southeast Spartans License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
18 Southeast High School Spartans and such plates shall be designed in
19 consultation with the Southeast High School Alumni Association;

20 78. Catoosa High School License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
22 Catoosa High School located in Catoosa. The plates shall bear the
23 image of the Catoosa High School mascot and be designed in
24 consultation with representatives of Catoosa High School;

1 79. Toastmasters International License Plate - such plates
2 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
3 Toastmasters International and shall be designed in consultation
4 with District 16 of Toastmasters International;

5 80. Millwood High School Alumni License Plate - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support for Millwood High School Alumni. The license plate shall be
8 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood High
9 School Alumni Association;

10 81. Patriot Guard Riders License Plate - such plates shall be
11 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for Patriot Guard
12 Riders and shall be designed in consultation with the Patriot Guard
13 Riders of Oklahoma; and

14 82. Bixby School District License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
16 the Bixby School District. The license plate shall be designed in
17 consultation with representatives of the Bixby School District.

18 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
19 per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
20 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
21 Registration Act. Unless otherwise provided in this section, the
22 fee shall be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year
23 of renewal of the special license plate fee shall be deposited in
24 the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the

1 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act
2 and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) per year of renewal of the
3 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
4 Section 1104 of this title.

5 SECTION 6. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.4, as
6 amended by Section 3, Chapter 69, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020,
7 Section 1135.4), is amended to read as follows:

8 Section 1135.4. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
9 authorized to design and issue personalized license plates. The
10 personalized license plates shall be issued on a staggered system
11 except for vintage decals.

12 Personalized special license plates shall not be transferred to
13 any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer
14 of ownership and retained. The personalized special license plate
15 may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other
16 vehicle has been registered for the current year.

17 Personalized special license plates shall be renewed each year
18 by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by
19 the Tax Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1)
20 year. The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued
21 special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary
22 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure
23 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.

24

1 The motor license agent fees for renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 On and after January 1, 2022, if a personalized license plate is
4 issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for
5 such plate pursuant to this section and the fee required pursuant to
6 Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at the same time and
7 subject to a single registration period. The Oklahoma Tax
8 Commission shall determine, by rule, a method for making required
9 fee and registration period adjustments if a special license plate
10 is obtained during a twelve-month period for which a registration
11 fee has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132 of this
12 title. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall not
13 alter the apportionment otherwise provided for in this section.

14 B. Such plates shall be designed and issued for the following:

15 1. Any person in any combination of numbers or letters from one
16 to a maximum of seven;

17 2. Persons eligible for two or more of the military decoration
18 special license plates provided for in this title. Such plates may
19 be issued in any combination of emblems. However, such plates shall
20 only display up to three emblems and shall also display any
21 combination of letters or numbers from one to a maximum of three;

22 3. Motorcycles in any combination of numbers or letters from
23 one to a maximum of six;

24

1 4. Persons eligible for Korean War Veteran license plates
2 provided for in this title. Such plates may display any combination
3 of letters or numbers up to three on each side of the insignia or
4 emblem;

5 5. Persons eligible for World War II Veteran license plates
6 provided for in this title. Such plates may display any combination
7 of letters or numbers up to three on each side of the insignia or
8 emblem; and

9 6. Persons owning vehicles which are twenty-one (21) years and
10 older are qualified to submit for approval by the Tax Commission or
11 a motor license agent a vintage but expired official Oklahoma
12 license plate which is twenty-one (21) years and older. Upon
13 approval of such personalized plate, the owner shall be issued the
14 annual registration decal which the Tax Commission or agent shall
15 direct to be affixed.

16 C. The fee for such plates shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per
17 year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other registration
18 fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
19 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the personalized tag
20 fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement
21 Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle
22 License and Registration Act. Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per year of
23 renewal of the personalized tag fee shall be apportioned as provided
24 in Section 1104 of this title.

1 SECTION 7. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
2 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
3 2020, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
6 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
7 financial assistance as provided by this section.

8 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
9 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
10 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
11 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
12 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

13 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
14 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
15 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
16 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special
17 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
18 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
19 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
20 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

21 On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is
22 issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for
23 such plate pursuant to this section and the fee required pursuant to
24 Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at the same time and

1 subject to a single registration period. The Oklahoma Tax
2 Commission shall determine, by rule, a method for making required
3 fee and registration period adjustments if a special license plate
4 is obtained during a twelve-month period for which a registration
5 fee has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132 of this
6 title. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall not
7 alter the apportionment otherwise provided for in this section.

8 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
9 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
10 applications for special license plates authorized under this
11 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
12 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
13 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
14 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
15 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
16 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
17 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
18 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
19 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

20 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
21 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
22 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
23 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
24 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license

1 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
2 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
3 removed from the vehicle.

4 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
5 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
6 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
7 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
8 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
9 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
10 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
11 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
12 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

13 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
14 follows:

15 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
18 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

20 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
22 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
23 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
24 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide

1 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
2 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
3 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
4 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
5 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
6 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
7 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
8 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
9 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
10 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
11 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

12 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
13 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
14 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
15 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
16 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
17 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
18 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
19 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
20 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
21 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
22 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
23 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
24 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire

1 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
2 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
3 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

4 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
5 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
6 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
7 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

8 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
10 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
11 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
12 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
13 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
14 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
15 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
16 plates.

17 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
18 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
19 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

20 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
22 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
23 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
24

1 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
2 the prevention of child abuse.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

5 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate -
6 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
8 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
9 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
10 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
11 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
12 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
13 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
14 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
15 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
16 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
17 issued;

18 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
20 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
21 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
22 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

23 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:
24

1 a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
2 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
3 provided in this section, an amount of the fee
4 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
5 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society
6 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66
7 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

8 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation
9 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The
10 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
11 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66
12 Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be
13 required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66
14 Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing
15 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma
16 Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty
17 Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate
18 issued;

19 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
21 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
22 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
23 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
24

1 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
2 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
5 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
6 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
8 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
9 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
10 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
11 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
12 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
13 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
16 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
17 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
18 Revolving Fund;

19 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
20 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
21 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
22 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
23 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
24 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for

1 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
2 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
3 provide services to crime victims;

4 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
6 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
7 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
8 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
9 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
10 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
11 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

12 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
13 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
14 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
16 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
17 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
18 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
19 Section 1104.4 of this title;

20 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
22 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in
23 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
24 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the

1 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
2 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
3 1104.3 of this title;

4 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
6 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
7 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
8 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
9 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
10 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
11 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
12 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

13 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
15 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
16 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
17 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
18 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
19 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
20 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
21 follows:

22 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
23 Reform Revolving Fund,
24

- 1 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
2 Education Revolving Fund,
3 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
4 Career Technology Fund, and
5 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
6 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
7 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
8 Oklahoma Statutes.

9 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
10 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
11 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
12 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
13 paragraph;

14 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
15 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
16 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
17 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
18 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
19 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
20 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
21 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
22 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
23 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
24 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to

1 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
2 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
3 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
4 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
5 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
6 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
7 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

8 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
11 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
12 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
13 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax
14 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
15 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
16 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
17 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
18 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
19 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

20 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
21 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
22 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
23 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
24 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and

1 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
2 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
3 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
4 of this title;

5 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
6 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
7 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
8 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
9 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
10 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
11 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
12 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

13 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
14 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
15 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
16 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
17 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of
18 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
19 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
20 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
21 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
22 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be
23 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of

24

1 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for
2 created families;

3 23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
4 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
5 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
6 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
7 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
8 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
9 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
10 this title;

11 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
13 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
14 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
15 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
16 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
17 Section 1104.7 of this title;

18 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed
19 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
20 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
21 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
22 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
23 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
24 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association

1 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
2 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
3 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
4 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
5 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

6 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
8 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
9 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
10 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
11 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,

8 Sooner State ABATE of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
9 license plate issued. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of
10 this section, the Sooner State ABATE License Plate is hereby
11 reauthorized effective November 1, 2019;

12 70. Oklahoma License to Educate License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
14 support for Oklahoma educators. Such plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with the State Department of Education. As provided in
16 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in
17 the Oklahoma Teacher Recruitment Revolving Fund created in Section
18 6-132 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

19 71. Piedmont Education Foundation License Plate - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
21 support for the Piedmont Public Schools Education Foundation. Such
22 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Foundation. As
23 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
24 deposited in the Piedmont Public Schools Education Foundation

1 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.28 of this
2 title;

3 72. The Pride of Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the University of Oklahoma Marching Band and shall be designed in
6 consultation with the University of Oklahoma Marching Band. The
7 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
8 licensing agreement with the University of Oklahoma or the
9 University of Oklahoma Marching Band for any licensing fees which
10 may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design. The
11 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Pride of
12 Oklahoma Fund at the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Inc. of not
13 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

14 73. Jenks Trojans License Plate - such plates shall be designed
15 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
16 Jenks School District. The license plates shall be designed in
17 consultation with the administration of the Jenks School District.
18 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
19 agreement with the Jenks School District for any licensing fees
20 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
21 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
22 Jenks School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
23 each license plate issued;

1 74. Bixby Spartans License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the Bixby School District. The license plates shall be designed in
4 consultation with the administration of the Bixby School District.
5 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
6 agreement with the Bixby School District for any licensing fees
7 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
8 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
9 Bixby School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
10 each license plate issued;

11 75. Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 support for the Oklahoma aviation industry and to promote awareness
14 of aviation and aerospace. Such plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and shall be
16 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
17 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Twenty-four
18 Dollars (\$24.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
19 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
20 provided in Section 91 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 76. Ducks Unlimited License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
23 Ducks Unlimited. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with
24 Ducks Unlimited. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to

1 enter into a licensing agreement with Ducks Unlimited for any
2 licensing fee which may be required in order to use the Ducks
3 Unlimited logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for
4 a payment to Ducks Unlimited of not more than Twenty Dollars
5 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

6 77. Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate - such
7 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
8 of those who are currently prisoners of war or missing in action and
9 provide financial support for current veterans. The license plates
10 shall be designed in consultation with Rolling Thunder Oklahoma. As
11 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
12 deposited in the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate
13 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.29 of this title;

14 78. Woodward Boomers License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
16 the Woodward School District. The license plates shall be designed
17 in consultation with the administration of the Woodward School
18 District. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
19 licensing agreement with the Woodward School District for any
20 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the school
21 district's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
22 for a payment to the Woodward School District of not more than
23 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

1 79. Clinton Public School Foundation License Plate - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Clinton Public School Foundation. The
4 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Clinton

23 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Music
24 Hall of Fame Inc. and issued to any member of the organization

1 wishing to demonstrate support. The Tax Commission shall be
2 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma
3 Music Hall of Fame Inc. for any licensing fees which may be required
4 in order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
5 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Music Hall of
6 Fame Inc. of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
7 plate issued. The plates shall incorporate a numbering system
8 agreed upon by the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame Inc. and the Tax
9 Commission. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this
10 section, the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame Inc. License Plate is
11 hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2019;

12 82. Techlahoma Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
13 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
14 Techlahoma Foundation. The license plate shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Techlahoma Foundation. The plate shall be
16 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
17 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. The Tax
18 Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
19 with the Techlahoma Foundation for any licensing fees, which may be
20 required in order to use the association's logo or design. The
21 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Techlahoma
22 Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
23 plate issued;

24

1 83. Bethany Public Schools Foundation License Plate - such
2 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for the Bethany Public Schools Foundation. The license plates shall
4 be designed in consultation with the administration of the Bethany
5 Public Schools Foundation. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
6 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Bethany
7 Public Schools Foundation for any licensing fees which may be
8 required in order to use the Foundation's logo or design. The
9 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Bethany
10 Public Schools Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)
11 for each license plate issued;

12 84. Cystic Fibrosis Foundation License Plate - such plates
13 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
14 Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with the administration of the Cystic Fibrosis
16 Foundation. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
17 enter into a licensing agreement with the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation
18 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
19 Foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
20 for a payment to the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation of not more than
21 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

22 85. Down Syndrome Association of Central Oklahoma License Plate
23 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
24 demonstrate support for the Down Syndrome Association of Central

1 Oklahoma. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with the
2 Association. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
3 collected shall be deposited in the Down Syndrome Association of
4 Central Oklahoma License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section
5 1104.30 of this title;

6 86. Elk City Education Foundation License Plate - such plates
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
8 support for the Elk City Education Foundation. Such plates shall be
9 designed in consultation with the Foundation. As provided in this
10 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
11 Elk City Education Foundation License Plate Revolving Fund created
12 in Section 1104.31 of this title;

13 87. A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma (ABATE)
14 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
15 person wishing to provide financial support for ABATE of Oklahoma.
16 Such plates shall be designed in consultation with ABATE of
17 Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
18 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
19 as for personalized plates. The license plate for a motorcycle may
20 be of similar design as space permits or a new design in order to
21 meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The
22 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
23 licensing agreement with ABATE of Oklahoma for any licensing fees
24 which may be required in order to use the ABATE of Oklahoma logo or

1 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
2 ABATE of Oklahoma of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
3 license plate issued;

4 88. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
5 be designed for a vehicle or motorcycle in any combination of
6 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
7 personalized plates, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
8 support for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
9 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
10 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
11 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
12 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
13 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
14 official logo or design of the organization. The license plate for
15 a motorcycle may be of similar design as space permits or a new
16 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle
17 license plate. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a
18 licensing agreement with the Downed Bikers Association for any
19 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
20 organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
21 provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers Association of not more
22 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate;

23 89. Eagle Scout License Plate - Such plates shall be designed
24 to demonstrate support for Eagle Scouts and shall include the Eagle

1 Scout logo. Plates may be issued to any person who can show proof
2 of having obtained the rank of Eagle Scout. The Oklahoma Tax
3 Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
4 with the various Oklahoma local councils for any licensing fees
5 which may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design.
6 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not more than
7 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued to the
8 specific Oklahoma local area Council designated by the applicant;

9 90. Extraordinary Educators License Plate - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any person wishing to provide financial
11 support for common education in Oklahoma. Such plates shall be
12 designed in consultation with the State Department of Education.
13 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
14 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
15 personalized plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the
16 fee collected shall be deposited in the Extraordinary Educators
17 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.32 of this
18 title;

19 91. Former Oklahoma Legislator License Plate - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any person who previously served as
21 a member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives or Oklahoma State
22 Senate. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
23 the Oklahoma Historical Society. As provided in this section, an
24 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma

1 Historical Society Capital Improvement and Operations Revolving Fund
2 created in Section 1.10a of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The
3 Tax Commission shall create and maintain a list of former members of
4 the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate
5 eligible to be issued such plates; provided, that no former member
6 of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate
7 shall be eligible to possess more than two of such plates at any one
8 time. The Tax Commission shall confer as needed with the Chief
9 Clerk of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Secretary of
10 the Oklahoma State Senate to confirm that such list is complete and
11 accurate;

12 92. Monarch Butterfly License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the operations of the Nature Conservancy of Oklahoma. Such plates
15 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
16 Nature Conservancy. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
17 into a licensing agreement with the Nature Conservancy of Oklahoma
18 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
19 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
20 for a payment to the Nature Conservancy of Oklahoma of not more than
21 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

22 93. Oklahoma Tennis Foundation License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support for the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation. The license plates

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Tennis
2 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
3 licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation for any
4 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
5 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
6 for a payment to the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation of not more than
7 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

8 94. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate - such plates shall
9 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
10 for the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation. The license plates
11 shall be designed in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars
12 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
13 licensing agreement with the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation for
14 any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
15 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
16 for a payment to the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation of not more
17 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

18 95. Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization License Plate - such
19 plates shall be designed and issued to any female veteran of any
20 branch of the United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate
21 support for the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization. The license
22 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Women
23 Veterans Organization. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
24 enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Women Veterans

1 Organization for any licensing fees which may be required in order
2 to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement
3 shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Women Veterans
4 Organization of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
5 license plate issued;

6 96. FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and
7 Technology) License Plate - such plates shall be issued to any
8 person wishing to demonstrate support for FIRST Robotics Programs.
9 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
10 administration of FIRST. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
11 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with FIRST for any
12 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the FIRST logo
13 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
14 FIRST of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
15 plate issued;

16 97. Pittsburg State University License Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
18 support for the Pittsburg State University. The license plates
19 shall be designed in consultation with Pittsburg State University.
20 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
21 agreement with Pittsburg State University for any licensing fees
22 which may be required in order to use the school foundation's logo
23 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
24

1 the Pittsburg State University of not more than Twenty Dollars
2 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; and

3 98. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
4 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the
5 Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth Festival held in the Historic
6 Greenwood District in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued
7 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
8 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
9 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Black Wall Street
10 Chamber of Commerce. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee
11 collected shall be deposited in the Historic Greenwood
12 District/Juneteenth Festival Revolving Fund established in Section ~~5~~
13 ~~of this act~~ 2368.32 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Two
14 Dollars (\$2.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
15 Public School Classroom Support Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
16 provided in Section 1-123 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

17 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
18 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
19 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
20 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

21 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other
22 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as
23 provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph
24 authorizing the special license plate;

1 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall
2 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
3 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
4 Registration Act; and

5 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
6 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

7 SECTION 8. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.6, is
8 amended to read as follows:

9 Section 1135.6. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
10 authorized to design and issue National Association for Stock Car
11 Auto Racing Driver ("NASCAR") Theme License Plates. Such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 interest in NASCAR auto racing. The plates shall be of such design
14 as the supplier of the license plates in consultation with the
15 Oklahoma Tax Commission may prescribe. The fee for such plate shall
16 be Forty Dollars (\$40.00) and shall be in addition to all other
17 registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
18 Registration Act. On and after January 1, 2022, if a special
19 license plate is issued pursuant to this section, any registration
20 fee required for such plate pursuant to this section and the fee
21 required pursuant to Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at
22 the same time and subject to a single registration period. The
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall determine, by rule, a method for
24 making required fee and registration period adjustments if a special

1 license plate is obtained during a twelve-month period for which a
2 registration fee has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132
3 of this title. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall
4 not alter the apportionment otherwise provided for in this section.

5 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
6 agreement with the supplier of such NASCAR Driver license plates or
7 other entity for any required licensing fees. The licensing
8 agreement shall provide for a payment of not more than Twenty-five
9 Percent (25%) of the fee authorized for each license plate issued.
10 Five Dollars (\$5.00) of the forty-dollar fee shall be apportioned to
11 the General Revenue Fund. The remaining amount of such fee shall be
12 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

13 For license plates numbered zero (0) through one hundred (100)
14 displaying a particular NASCAR Driver theme, the Oklahoma Tax
15 Commission may establish an auction or similar procedure for the
16 purpose of determining the order in which such distinctive license
17 plates are sold and the amount of the additional fee for the
18 distinctive license plates. This amount shall be due at the time
19 the original application is submitted to the Tax Commission and
20 Forty Dollars (\$40.00) thereafter annually at the time of renewal
21 registration.

22 SECTION 9. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.7, as
23 amended by Section 5, Chapter 69, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020,
24 Section 1135.7), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 1135.7. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission or private
2 vendor with whom the Commission has contracted is authorized to
3 design and issue special license plates to any person that applies
4 to the Tax Commission or private vendor for the creation of a
5 special license plate and meets the minimum standards and
6 qualifications specified in this section.

7 B. If the following standards and guidelines are satisfied, the
8 Tax Commission shall authorize the issuance of a special license
9 plate to the person making application for the special license
10 plate:

11 1. The license plate is to:

- 12 a. show membership in or affiliation with an
- 13 organization, or
- 14 b. demonstrate support for an organization, group or
- 15 cause;

16 2. The license plate does not advertise or endorse a product,
17 brand, or service that is provided for sale;

18 3. The license plate does not promote any philosophy based on
19 prejudice or that is contrary to state civil rights laws; and

20 4. Two hundred prepaid applications for the special license
21 plate are received by the Tax Commission or private vendor.

22 C. The fee for special license plates shall be determined in
23 accordance with Section ~~1 of this act~~ 1135.9 of this title. If the
24 special license plate does not provide financial assistance the fee

1 shall be no less than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per year of renewal
2 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by
3 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise
4 provided in this section, Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) of the fee shall
5 be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special
6 license plate fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission
7 Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma
8 Vehicle License and Registration Act and the remaining amounts of
9 the special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
10 Section 1104 of this title.

11 D. The fee for special license plates that provide financial
12 assistance shall be determined in accordance with Section ~~1 of this~~
13 ~~act~~ 1135.9 of this title. Provided, the fee shall be no less than
14 Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other
15 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
16 Registration Act. Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) per year of renewal
17 of the fee shall be apportioned as follows:

18 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to
19 the License Plate Special Program Assistance Revolving Fund created
20 in Section 1135.8 of this title to be used in the manner detailed in
21 the application for the special license plate;

22 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
24

1 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
2 and

3 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
4 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

5 E. If a person applies for a special license plate that
6 provides financial assistance, the application shall designate a
7 state agency to be responsible for expending the funds generated by
8 the special license plate and the application shall designate a
9 specific public purpose for which the funds are to be used. The
10 application shall include an acknowledgment from the designated
11 state agency of their agreement with acceptance of the designated
12 funds.

13 F. Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
14 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
15 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
16 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
17 registered for the current year.

18 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
19 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
20 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
21 The Tax Commission shall notify all persons issued special license
22 plates of the renewal procedures prior to the expiration of the
23 special license plate. The notice shall contain all necessary
24 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure

1 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.
2 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

3 On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is
4 issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for
5 such plate and the fee required pursuant to Section 1132 of this
6 title shall be remitted at the same time and subject to a single
7 registration period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall determine,
8 by rule, a method for making required fee and registration period
9 adjustments if a special license plate is obtained during a twelve-
10 month period for which registration has already been remitted
11 pursuant to Section 1132 of this title. The combination of fees in
12 a single remittance shall not alter the apportionment otherwise
13 provided for in this section.

14 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
15 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
16 applications for special license plates authorized under this
17 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
18 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
19 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
20 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
21 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
22 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
23 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
24

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 G. All special plates issued by the Tax Commission prior to ~~the~~
4 ~~effective date of this act~~ November 1, 2005 shall not be subject to
5 the requirements and qualifications outlined in this section.

6 H. As used in this section, "person" includes an individual,
7 group, organization or not-for-profit corporation that is recognized
8 as such by the Internal Revenue Service.

9 SECTION 10. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1141.1, as
10 amended by Section 4, Chapter 158, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020,

1 2. Beginning on or after January 1, 2022, and for all
2 subsequent years, if a special or personalized license plate is
3 issued pursuant to Sections 1135.1 through 1135.7 of this title and
4 remittance is combined with the registration required pursuant to
5 Section 1132 of this title, Seven Dollars and twelve cents (\$7.12);

6 3. One Dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) for each
7 certificate of title issued for boats and motors pursuant to the
8 Oklahoma Statutes;

9 ~~3.~~ 4. For each certificate of registration issued for boats and
10 motors pursuant to the Oklahoma Statutes, an amount determined
11 pursuant to the provisions of subsection B of this section;

12 ~~4.~~ 5. Two Dollars and twenty-five cents (\$2.25) for each
13 certificate of title issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Vehicle License
14 and Registration Act. Provided, the fee retention amount for
15 certificates of title issued pursuant to the provisions of
16 subsection H of Section 1105 of this title, in which an insurer pays
17 the optional twenty-two-dollar-fee amount, is Four Dollars and fifty
18 cents (\$4.50);

19 ~~5.~~ 6. Beginning October 1, 2000, three percent (3%) of the
20 vehicle excise tax collected pursuant to Section 2103 of Title 68 of
21 the Oklahoma Statutes. Beginning July 1, 2001, each motor license
22 agent shall be entitled to retain three and one hundred twenty-five
23 one-thousandths percent (3.125%) of the vehicle excise tax collected
24 pursuant to Section 2103 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 Beginning July 1, 2002, and for all subsequent years, each motor
2 license agent shall be entitled to retain three and twenty-five one-
3 hundredths percent (3.25%) of the vehicle excise tax collected

5 However, beginning July 1, 2003, the Legislature shall annually

16 ~~9.~~ 10. Two Dollars (\$2.00) for each inspection conducted
17 pursuant to subsection L of Section 1105 of this title;

18 ~~10.~~ 11. Three Dollars (\$3.00) for each inspection conducted
19 pursuant to subsection M of Section 1105 of this title;

20 ~~11.~~ 12. One Dollar (\$1.00) for each certificate of ownership
21 filed pursuant to subsection R of Section 1105 of this title;

22 ~~12.~~ 13. One Dollar (\$1.00) for each temporary permit issued
23 pursuant to Section 1124 of this title;

1 ~~13.~~ 14. One Dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) for processing each
2 proof of financial responsibility, driver license information,
3 insurance verification information, and other additional information
4 as provided in Section 7-602 of this title;

6 Sections 1131 and 1140 of this title;

7 ~~15.~~ 16. The notary fee provided in Section 1143 of this title;

9 completed and recorded on a certificate of title pursuant to
10 subsection G of Section 1105 of this title;

11 ~~17.~~ 18. Seven Dollars (\$7.00) for each notice of transfer as
12 provided by subsection B of Section 1107.4 of this title;

13 ~~18.~~ 19. Seven Dollars (\$7.00) for each certificate of title or
14 each certificate of registration issued for repossessed vehicles
15 pursuant to Section 1126 of this title;

18 of a traffic record; and

22 C of Section 1115, subsection F of Section 1132 and subsection C of

24 Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 The balance of the funds collected shall be remitted to the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission as provided in Section 1142 of this title to
3 be apportioned pursuant to Section 1104 of this title.

4 B. For each certificate of registration issued for boats and
5 motors, each motor license agent shall be entitled to retain the
6 greater of One Dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) or an amount to
7 be determined by the Tax Commission according to the provisions of
8 this subsection. At the end of fiscal year 1997 and each fiscal
9 year thereafter, the Tax Commission shall compute the average amount
10 of registration fees for all boats and motors registered in this
11 state during the fiscal year and shall multiply the result by six
12 and twenty-two one-hundredths percent (6.22%). The resulting
13 product shall be the amount which may be retained by each motor
14 license agent for each certificate of registration for boats and
15 motors issued during the following calendar year.

16 SECTION 11. This act shall become effective January 1, 2022.
