10	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 510, is

12	Section 510. <u>A.</u> Any person, otherwise qualified, who has shall		
13	be eligible to hold the office of county sheriff or to file as a		
14	<pre>candidate therefor if such person:</pre>		
15	1. Has been a resident of the State of Oklahoma for two (2)		
16	years <del>, has</del> ;		
17	2. Has been a registered voter of the party whose nomination he		
18	or she seeks, or a registered Independent, within the county from		
19	which such person seeks election, for the six (6) months next		
20	preceding the first day of the filing period, except in 2004, when		
21	such person must have been a qualified registered elector no later		
22	than December 21, 2003, is;		
23	3. Is at least twenty-five (25) years of age next preceding the		
24	date of filing for office, possesses;		

- - 5. Has served as a duly certified peace officer, in a full-time capacity, for a period of three (3) years or more prior to the date of filing for the office of county sheriff; and
  - 6. In counties with populations of five hundred thousand (500,000) or more, the person seeking election shall also be a holds a current certified certification as a peace officer in good standing.
  - B. Within twelve (12) months of taking office, all newly elected or appointed sheriffs shall complete a sheriff's administrative school which has been developed by the Oklahoma Sheriff's Association and which has been approved by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET). Failure to complete the sheriff's administrative school within the specified period shall preclude the new sheriff from obtaining CLEET certification.

    New sheriffs with prior CLEET certification, who fail to attend the sheriff's administrative school, shall have their CLEET certification revoked.
  - <u>C.</u> Provided, however, the provisions of this section relating to qualifications shall not apply to any person serving as a county sheriff or to any person previously serving as county sheriff prior to the adoption of this statute.
