2 <u>shall commence. The</u> right-of-way over real property granted in this

(b) Provided, however, the State Highway Transportation 5 Commission, in the exercise of reasonable discretion, may prevent 6 7 the installation of such facilities upon limited access highways which are a part of the National System of Interstate and Defense 8 9 Highways, or such Commission may permit the installation of such 10 facilities on such portion of Interstate and Defense Highways under 11 such reasonable regulations as it may prescribe. Provided, further, 12 nothing herein contained shall affect the right of the owners of 13 telephone and telegraph lines to cross such Interstate and Defense Highways and to build their lines either aerial or underground along 14 15 and upon any extension of said interstate and defense highways within urban areas in accordance with Federal Aid Regulations. 16 17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
