B. A filing fee received by the Secretary of the State Election
Board shall be deposited in the State Election Board Revolving Fund
created pursuant to Section 3-107 of this title. A filing fee
received by a secretary of a county election board shall be
deposited in the County Election Board Special Depository Account
authorized by Section 3-108 of this title.

9 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 20-102, is 10 amended to read as follows:

Section 20-102. A. Candidates for the nomination for President 11 12 of the United States shall file with the Secretary of the State Election Board. Such candidates shall be members of political 13 parties recognized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma and shall 14 have filed a statement of candidacy with the Federal Election 15 Commission and shall have raised and expended not less than Five 16 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for said office. The candidates shall 17 be required to swear an oath or affirm that they meet the 18 aforementioned qualifications, and their signatures shall be 19 witnessed by a notary public. Such filing beginning at 8:00 a.m. on 20 the first Monday in December and ending at 5:00 p.m. on the next 21 succeeding Wednesday, or at a time prescribed by the State Election 22 Board for a Presidential Preferential Primary to be held on a date 23 other than the first Tuesday in March. A statement of candidacy 24

1 must be accompanied by a petition supporting a candidate's filing 2 signed by one percent (1%) of the registered voters in each 3 congressional district eligible to vote for a candidate or one thousand (1,000) registered voters in each congressional district 4 5 eligible to vote for a candidate, whichever is less, as reflected by the latest January 15 registration report; or by a cashier's check 6 or certified check in the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred 7 Dollars (\$2,500.00) Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00). The State 8 9 Election Board shall cause the names of all candidates who have 10 filed within the proper time to be printed on the official ballots. 11 The ballots shall be prepared as provided for by law. Voters shall be restricted to one vote for the candidate of his or her choice of 12 13 the political party in which the voter is registered.

B. Each page of a petition supporting a candidate's filing
shall identify the county and the congressional district, and shall
contain the names of registered voters in only one congressional
district and in only one county.

18 C. Each page of a petition supporting a candidate's filing 19 shall be verified. Verification shall be made in substantial 20 compliance with the provisions of Section 6 of Title 34 of the 21 Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
