7 An Act relating to offender supervision; directing  
8 persons requesting transfer to another state to pay a  
9 transfer application fee; allowing certain action by  
10 the Director; directing deposit of collected fees;  
11 providing for codification; and providing an  
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1097 of Title 22, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Persons convicted in this state, who make a request for transfer  
18 to another state pursuant to the Interstate Compact as prescribed in  
19 Section 1093 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall pay a  
20 transfer application fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each  
21 transfer application submitted. The transfer application fee shall  
22 be paid to the Department of Corrections upon submission of the  
23 transfer application. The Director of the Department or the  
24 Director's designee may waive the application fee if it is  
determined that the payment of the fee will constitute an undue

1 economic burden on the offender. All fees collected pursuant to  
2 this section shall be deposited into the Department of Corrections  
3 Revolving Fund.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
