The transfer application fee shall 17 be paid to the Department of Corrections upon submission of the 18 transfer application. The Director of the Department or the 19 Director's designee may waive the application fee if it is 20 determined that the payment of the fee will constitute an undue 21 economic burden on the offender. All fees collected pursuant to 22 this section shall be deposited into the Department of Corrections 23 Revolving Fund. 24
