NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1097 of Title 22, unless there 19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 Persons convicted in this state, who make a request for transfer 21 to another state pursuant to the Interstate Compact as prescribed in 22 Section 1093 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall pay a 23 transfer application fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each 24 transfer application submitted. The transfer application fee shall

1	be paid to the Department of Corrections upon submission of the
2	transfer application. The Director of the Department or the
3	Director's designee may waive the application fee if it is
4	determined that the payment of the fee will constitute an undue
5	economic burden on the offender. All fees collected pursuant to
6	this section shall be deposited into the Department of Corrections
7	Revolving Fund.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
