6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to presidential electors; amending 26
8 O.S. 2011, Section 10-103, which relates to election
9 of presidential electors; modifying time for election
10 of presidential electors; modifying entity to elect
11 presidential electors; establishing contingency for
12 expiration of certain requirements; providing
13 exception upon enactment of certain federal law; and
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 10-103, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 10-103. A. On the third Tuesday after the first Monday
19 in November in each year next preceding the expiration of the term
20 of office of each President of the United States, the Legislature of
21 this state shall convene pursuant to the provisions of Section 27A
22 of Article 5 of the Oklahoma Constitution and shall elect a number
23 of electors for President and Vice President equal to the number of
24 United States Senators and United States Representatives which the
state is entitled to elect. If a federal law is enacted pursuant to
clause 1 of Section 4 of Article 1 of the United States Constitution

1 that requires security measures for elections including, but not
2 limited to, voter identification requirements and the use of
3 auditable paper ballots, the provisions of this subsection shall
4 cease to be in effect on the effective date of such federal law.

5 B. ~~On~~ Except as provided by subsection A of this section, on
6 the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in each year
7 next preceding the expiration of the term of office of each
8 President of the United States, the registered voters of this state
9 shall elect a number of electors for President and Vice President
10 equal to the number of United States Senators and United States
11 Representatives which the state is entitled to elect. Said electors
12 shall be elected in the same manner as is provided for state
13 officers.

14 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
