9	design of plate; reauthorizing Chiefs of Police license plate; and providing effective date.

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
14	last amended by Section 3, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp.
15	2014, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:
16	A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design
17	and issue appropriate official special license plates to persons
18	wishing to demonstrate support and provide financial assistance as
19	provided by this section.
20	Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
21	person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
22	ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
23	on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
24	registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 2 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 3 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 4 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 5 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 6 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 7 issued on a staggered system.

The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 8 9 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 10 applications for special license plates authorized under this section. 11 The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 12 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 13 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 14 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 15 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 16 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 17 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 18 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. 19

If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license

1 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 2 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 3 removed from the vehicle.

For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, 4 5 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid 6 7 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the 8 9 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall 10 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are 11 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time 12 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide

1 general public environmental education program created pursuant to Such 2 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. 3 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 4 5 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated 6 7 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by 8 9 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in 10 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned 11 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

12 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid. 13 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four 14 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a 15 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an 16 17 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 18 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 19 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 20 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may 21 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated 22 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon 23 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire 24

1 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
2 of the fire department.

3 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more 4 5 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue. Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese 6 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color 7 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word 8 9 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for 10 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new 11 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design 12 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other 13 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each 14 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue. 15

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building & Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and Living Memorial;

Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in

1 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in 2 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may 3 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license 4 plates.

5 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 6 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of 7 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
the prevention of child abuse.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -16 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 17 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. 18 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers 19 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized 20 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States 21 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if 22 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United 23 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be 24

1 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or 2 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not 3 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate 4 issued;

7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

10 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be 11 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother 12 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 13 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving 14 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton, 15 Oklahoma;

9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates24 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency

1 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical 2 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 3 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in 4 5 consultation with the state association of emergency medical technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee 6 7 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63 8 9 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be 11 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of 12 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount 13 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act 14 Revolving Fund;

12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 15 16 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 17 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims 18 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 19 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for 20 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use 21 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to 22 provide services to crime victims; 23

1 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates 2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 3 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 4 5 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -6 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to 7 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program; 8

9 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed, 10 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the 11 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 12 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued 13 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to 14 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in 15 Section 1104.4 of this title; 16

15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 17 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 18 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 19 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued 20 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag 21 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an 22 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 23 Section 1104.3 of this title; 24

1 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates 2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. 3 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 4 5 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 6 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial 7 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of 8 9 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be 11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 12 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the 13 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license 14 15 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three 16 17 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as follows: 18

- a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
 Reform Revolving Fund,
- b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
 Education Revolving Fund,
- c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
 Career Technology Fund, and

d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
 Oklahoma Statutes.

However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this paragraph;

10 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of 11 12 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the 13 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as 14 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate 15 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in 16 17 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown. 18 emblem. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 19 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 20 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 21 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the 22 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 23 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired 24

Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such 4 19. 5 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall 6 7 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. 8 9 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. 10 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into 11 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any 12 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide 13 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty 14 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; 15

Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such 16 20. plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the 17 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 18 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state 19 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and 20 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 21 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of 22 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5 23 of this title; 24

1 Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates 21. 2 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and 3 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma 4 5 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation 6 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and 7 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks; 8

9 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates 10 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of 11 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for 12 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and 13 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates 14 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation 15 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human 16 17 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury 18 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the 19 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act 20 specifically for created families; 21

Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall 7 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 8 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The 9 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 10 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an 11 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 12 Section 1104.7 of this title;

25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed 13 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions 14 15 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, 16 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be 17 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation 18 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association 19 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter 20 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service 21 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to 22 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars 23 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued; 24

Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 3 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting 4 5 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section, 6 7 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.8 of this title; 8

9 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter 10 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the 11 12 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of 13 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain 14 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. 15 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a 16 17 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use 18 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. 19 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts 20 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout 21 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 22 plate issued; 23

1 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such 2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 3 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City 4 5 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon 6 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the 7 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing 8 9 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial 10 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 11 plate issued;

Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the 6 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet 7 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the 8 9 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.10 of this title; 10

Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in 11 32. 12 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who 13 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active 14 15 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 16 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion 17 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate 18 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title; 19

33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on

Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in

34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -6 7 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. 8 The 9 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers 10 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized 11 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls 12 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America 13 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the 14 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to 13 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for 14 each license plate issued; 15

Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall 16 40. be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support 17 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization 18 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal 19 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and 20 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military 21 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in 22 action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan. 23 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of 24

The license plates shall be 8 9 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of 10 Police. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar design 11 as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space 12 requirements of a motorcycle license plate.
