An Act relating to public health; amending 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-229.23, which relates to prevention of youth access to tobacco; updating statutory references; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Youth access to tobacco

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-229.23, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-229.23. Any city or town that enacts and enforces ordinances prohibiting and penalizing conduct under provisions of ~~Section 600.3, 600.4, 600.8 or 600.9 of this title~~ Section 1-229.13, 1-229.18, or 1-229.19 of this title or Section 2-8-224 of Title 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes shall furnish information requested by the ~~ABLE~~ Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission in the form, manner and time as may be determined by the ABLE Commission which will allow the ABLE Commission to comply with ~~subsection C of Section 600.11 of this title~~ subsection H of Section 1-229.22 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
