6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to voter registration; providing  
8 procedures for voter registration on election days;  
9 providing for establishment of identity and  
10 residency; requiring oath under certain  
11 circumstances; providing for casting of a provisional  
12 ballot by such registrants; providing for  
13 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7-115.3 of Title 26, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. A person who is eligible to register to vote, but is not  
19 registered, may register on the days set forth in Section 14-115.4  
20 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes by appearing in person at the  
21 office of the county election board and completing a voter  
22 registration application, making written oath, and providing proof  
23 of identity as set forth in Section 7-114 of Title 26 of the  
24 Oklahoma Statutes. The method of registration set forth in this  
section shall be in addition to any other method of registration

1 provided by law. If the identification presented does not contain  
2 the person's current address in the precinct, the person may be  
3 requested to present another form of proof of identity that shows  
4 the person's name and address in the precinct.

5 B. The oath required pursuant to subsection A of this section  
6 shall be attached to the voter registration application, and the  
7 information contained in the oath shall be recorded on the voter  
8 registration records of the person registering to vote.

9 C. A person applying to register to vote as provided in this  
10 section shall be permitted to vote on the day of registration if the  
11 county election board makes a determination that the person is  
12 qualified to become a registered voter.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
