12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-3.1B of Title 74, unless
15	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. As used in this section:
17	1. "Race or sex stereotyping" means ascribing character traits,
18	values, moral and ethical codes, privileges, status, or beliefs to a
19	race or sex, or to an individual because of his or her race or sex;
20	and
21	2. "Race or sex scapegoating" means assigning fault, blame, or
22	bias to a race or sex, or to an individual because of his or her
23	race or sex. It similarly encompasses any claim that, consciously
24 2 -	or unconsciously, and by virtue of their race or sex, members of any

<sup>1</sup> race are inherently racist or are inherently inclined to oppress
<sup>2</sup> others, or that members of a sex are inherently sexist or inclined
<sup>3</sup> to oppress others.

B. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, every agency or
department of the state, county or municipality, or political
subdivision shall be prohibited from adopting a policy or training
materials to promote race or sex stereotyping or scapegoating.

8 Nothing in this section prevents agencies or departments of this 9 state from promoting racial, cultural, or ethnic diversity or 10 inclusiveness, provided such efforts are consistent with the 11 requirements of this section.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
