16	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no state entity or
17	political subdivision of this state shall, through direct or
18	indirect means, compel or coerce any person under its jurisdiction
19	to undergo any unwanted medical procedure including, but not limited
20	to, an immunization, to use any unwanted medical device or to wear
21	any face covering. A person who violates this section shall be
22	guilty of a misdemeanor. Nothing in this section shall be construed
23	to apply to an employer, unless such employer is a state entity or
24 27	political subdivision. As used in this section, "political

1	subdivision" means a county, city, town, school district or other
2	local governmental or public entity located within this state.
3	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
5	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
