11 An Act relating to crime and punishment; amending 21
12 O.S. 2011, Section 540, which relates to obstructing
13 an officer; stating certain allowances; and providing
14 an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 540, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 540. Any person who willfully delays or obstructs any
20 public officer in the discharge or attempt to discharge any duty of
21 his or her office, is guilty of a misdemeanor. Nothing in this
22 section shall preclude a person from recording the activity of law
23 enforcement in a public area, as long as the recording activity does
24

1 not delay or obstruct the law enforcement agent in his or her
2 duties.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
