An Act relating to crime and punishment; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 540, which relates to obstructing an officer; stating certain allowances; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Right to record law enforcement activity

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 540, is amended to read as follows:

Section 540. Any person who willfully delays or obstructs any public officer in the discharge or attempt to discharge any duty of his <u>or her</u> office, is guilty of a misdemeanor. <u>Nothing in this</u> <u>section shall preclude a person from recording the activity of law</u> <u>enforcement in a public area, as long as the recording activity does</u> <u>not delay or obstruct the law enforcement agent in his or her</u> <u>duties.</u>

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
