6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to Grand River Dam Authority;  
8 amending 82 O.S. 2011, Section 866, as last amended  
9 by Section 8, Chapter 507, O.S.L. 2019 (82 O.S. Supp.  
10 2020, Section 866), which relates to operations of  
the district; moving the domicile of the district;  
11 updating statutory language; providing an effective  
12 date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2011, Section 866, as last  
15 amended by Section 8, Chapter 507, O.S.L. 2019 (82 O.S. Supp. 2020,  
16 Section 866), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 866. The domicile of the district shall be in the ~~City~~  
18 ~~of Vinita,~~ County of ~~Craig~~ Mayes, where the district shall maintain  
19 its principal office in charge of its Chief Executive Officer, until  
20 otherwise designated by the affirmative vote of four directors. The  
21 district shall cause to be kept complete and accurate accounts  
22 conforming to any generally accepted accounting principles. The  
23 accounts and all contracts, documents and records of the district  
24 shall be kept at the principal office. The accounts and contracts

1 shall be open to public inspection at all reasonable times. The  
2 Board shall cause to be made and completed within ninety (90) days  
3 after the end of each calendar year an audit of the books of account  
4 and financial records of the district for such calendar year, such  
5 audit to be made by an independent certified public accountant or  
6 firm of certified public accountants. Electronic copies of the  
7 audit report, certified to by the accountant or accountants, shall  
8 be placed and kept on file with the Governor, the State Treasurer,  
9 Oklahoma Department of Libraries and the State Auditor and Inspector  
10 ~~of the State of Oklahoma~~, and at the principal office, and shall be  
11 open to public inspection at all reasonable times. The audit shall  
12 also be filed with the Director of the Office of Management and  
13 Enterprise Services, in accordance with the requirements set forth  
14 for financial statement audits in Section 212A of Title 74 of the  
15 Oklahoma Statutes.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
