L 6	Section 866. The domicile of the district shall be in the City

20	district shall cause to be kept complete and accurate accounts

shall be open to public inspection at all reasonable times. The

1 Board shall cause to be made and completed within ninety (90) days after the end of each calendar year an audit of the books of account 2 3 and financial records of the district for such calendar year, such audit to be made by an independent certified public accountant or 5 firm of certified public accountants. Electronic copies of the audit report, certified to by the accountant or accountants, shall 6 7 be placed and kept on file with the Governor, the State Treasurer, Oklahoma Department of Libraries and the State Auditor and Inspector 9 of the State of Oklahoma, and at the principal office, and shall be 10 open to public inspection at all reasonable times. The audit shall 11 also be filed with the Director of the Office of Management and 12 Enterprise Services, in accordance with the requirements set forth for financial statement audits in Section 212A of Title 74 of the 13 Oklahoma Statutes. 14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021. 15 16 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 18
