SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) to be transferred to the Urban Gardens Grant Revolving Fund created in Section 5-122 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) for the purpose of hiring a coordinator to develop plans to create a Civil Rights Trail visitor center.
