10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1151.22, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 1151.22. A. Any contract entered into under the
14	Roofing Contractor Registration Act shall include a statement that
15	all individuals performing work under the contract are covered by
16	workers' compensation insurance.
17	B. If the individuals performing work under the contract are
18	not covered by an affidavit of exemption for workers' compensation
19	insurance, the contractor shall provide a written statement to the
20	homeowner advising that the individuals performing work under the
21	contract are not covered by workers' compensation insurance, which
22	is used by a legitimately exempt person, it shall be signed by all
23	parties to the contract and attached to the contract and it shall be
24	used only for new residential construction projects. All commercial

1	projects and any maintenance or repair to an existing residential
2	structure shall require all individuals performing work on such
3	project to be covered by worker's compensation insurance as
4	employees of the person registered under the Roofing Contractor
5	Registration Act. However, any day laborer who can show proof of
6	being covered by workers' compensation insurance under the temporary
7	labor agency for whom he or she is hired-out may provide an
8	affidavit from the temporary labor agency to meet the requirement of
9	this section for authority to use an affidavit of exemption. No
10	roofing contractor required to be registered under the Roofing
11	Contractor Registration Act shall hire any out-of-state company or
12	person or use any person or independent contractor that is not
13	registered under the Roofing Contractor Registration Act with the
14	required worker's compensation insurance or who is not deemed his or
15	her employee for purposes of workers' compensation insurance.
16	C. In no event shall a home owner be held liable for injury or
17	death to any person who performs work under a contract with a person
18	required by law to be registered under the Roofing Contractor
19	Registration Act and have workers' compensation on all persons
20	performing work on the roofing project.
21	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
