17	not use public monies for the advocacy or promotion of gun control
18	and shall be specifically prohibited from doing any of the

20	1. Using publicity or propaganda for the purposes of advocating
21	or promoting gun control or preparing, distributing or using any
22	kit, pamphlet, booklet, publication, electronic communication or
23	radio, television or video presentation designed to support or

defeat the enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation or administrative action relating to gun control;

- 2. Paying the salary or expenses of any grant or contract recipient or agent acting on behalf of the recipient, if the grant or contract is related to any activity designed to influence the enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation or administrative action relating to gun control; or
- 3. Advocating or promoting any proposed, pending or future federal, state or local tax increase relating to gun control, or any proposed, pending or future requirement or restriction on any legal consumer product, including the sale and marketing of the legal consumer product relating to the advocacy or promotion of gun control.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
